

### 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year A) Sunday 12 February 2023 "With all your Heart, Soul and Mind"

Hillel, a famous rabbi who lived a few years before Jesus was once asked by a young gentile to teach him the whole Torah in the time he could stand on one

young gentile to teach him the whole Torah in the time he could stand on one leg. Hillel replied: "What you would not want done to you, don't do to another! This is the whole law: the rest is commentary."

Another rabbi who lived in Alexandria at the time of Jesus held that the whole of the Torah was summed up in the ten commandments given by God to Moses and that this in turn could be summed up in love of God and neighbour.

But there were others insisted on so many rules, regulations and practices for correct observance that not only was a heavy yoke placed on the faithful people of God but the Spirit of the Covenant could be overlooked or misunderstood.

The Gospel of Matthew makes clear from the beginning that Jesus' mission is to live and draw all into the active love and righteousness of God. This is brought to realization not only through His words and ministry but His living and love for all people.

In the text today Jesus is speaking to people who are well aware of the commandments, observances and expectations as keepers of God's Covenant. However, He insists that in their attitudes and behavior they must go beyond a mere legal observance. Doing only what the Law states as a minimum is not enough. He is talking about acting according to the will of God who is all-loving, all-merciful, forgiving and longs to draw all- particularly the vulnerable, lowly and socially excluded into His embrace.

Jesus reassures His hearers that 'not one dot, one little stroke, shall disappear from the Law.' Instead, He urges His listeners to interpret it in a new way. His emphasis is on the spirit of the Law, not the letter. Disciples are called to discern what is at the ground of Faith which is to participate in the Righteousness of a God whose Spirit is Love and share this with all.

In all examples Jesus gives relating to anger, adultery, divorce and oaths, He is not writing a new law but stressing the radical demands of the kingdom. His challenge is to go beyond meeting the requirements of outward observances, look into our hearts and to admit our need of help in living as God wants us to. This gospel makes clear that this humanly impossible task can be realized only with the help of the Spirit of God: and the task Jesus has set for us and was, Himself it's perfect expression is:

LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF. "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.
This is the first and greatest commandment'. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." Matt 22: 36.-40
We cannot love God if we do not love one another.
