A MESSAGE FROM WALK #188 SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

Dear The objective of Emmaus is “to inspire, challenge, and equip the local church members for Christian action in their homes, churches, communities and places of work. Emmaus lifts up a way for our grace-filled lives to be lived and shared with others.” As the pilgrims experience the enjoyment of “three days of singing, learning, laughing, worshiping, reflecting, praying and participating in small groups” it is hoped that they will be empowered to be leaders through becoming the hands and feet of Jesus Christ.

As we approach the beginning of Walk 189, please be in prayer for the team members that we can help the pilgrims discover how grace can become real in their lives, how they can live a life of grace and how they can bring that grace to others when they return home to live their fourth days. And please be in prayer for the pilgrims as they are invited through the work of the Holy Spirit to have a closer walk with Christ for the rest of their lives. Also pray that they will “expand their own spiritual lives through worship, study and active participation in their local church and become more active Disciples of Christ in service to the world.”

As Spiritual Director for Walk 189, it is my prayer that the pilgrims may experience what the two disciples experienced as they walked with Jesus on the road to Emmaus:

“And yet, the risen Christ ‘came near and went with them, ‘opening the disciples’ eyes to His presence and lighting the fire of God’s love in their hearts. As they walked to Emmaus, Jesus explained to them the meaning of all the scriptures concerning himself. When they arrived in Emmaus, Jesus ‘took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them,’ and their eyes were opened. They recognized him as Jesus, the risen Lord, and they remembered how their hearts had burned within them as they talked with him on the road. Within the hour, the two disciples left Emmaus and returned immediately to their friends in Jerusalem. As they told stories about their encounters with the risen Lord, Jesus visited them again with a fresh awareness of his living presence.”

I also pray that the pilgrims that God has sent to us receive “fresh awareness of His living presence.” Thank you for letting me serve the Central Alabama Emmaus Community as Spiritual Director for Walk189.
