# Pastor's COLUMN

Today we highlight our belief of One God in Three Persons –Father, Son and Holy Spirit– as we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity. The term “trinity” is a Latin-based word from *trinitas*, meaning the number three or triad. It also means the state of being threefold or triple. It became a term to talk about God in early times and the relationship of the Father, Son and Spirit. Today we focus on the image of God in which we have been created. The Trinity shares God’s inner life with the Church –the Body of Christ animated by the Spirit. In essence this feast celebrates the “community” of God and offers us a model for living in love and harmony with one another. Today’s reading finds Jesus speaking and making reference to the Spirit of truth and to the Father. As such, this is one of many texts used to develop the understanding of the Trinity. We believe in one God of three persons and are reminded today that to know God as a Trinity of Persons is to be drawn into a relationship of love which is at the heart of who God is. Thus the Feast of the Holy Trinity inspires praise and glory in all of us this day.

Many thanks to all who made our recent Easter season one of joy and blessings -- to our Parish Liturgy Committee for their unique and inspiring environment; to our Music Ministry for their weekly joyful contribution to our prayer and praise; and to our many liturgical ministers for their faithful and dedicated service to God and our parish. “*With grace and gladness*” our parish celebrated a wonderful Lent and Easter Season!

**Anointing of the Sick** — If you are anticipating surgery or a hospital stay remember to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick any time after Mass. Please contact Fr. Balash to receive the sacrament.

**Receiving Communion While Recovering** — If you or a family member become homebound, even if only for a short recovery time, please call the parish office so arrangements can be made for visitation and reception of Holy Communion.
