

How to Plead the Blood of Jesus in Prayer

By pleading the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ is one of the most effective way to pray to overcome the enemy, to protect ourselves and our families and for the protection of our property and possessions. We all need protection against satan and his demons. The last days are upon us and the world is becoming increasingly dangerous. However protection for you and your family during this time is possible, you can put worry to rest. For many these last days can be full of dread, fear, and insecurity. For the church they will be our best ever! Don't let terror defeat you."

Do you want to start pleading the blood of Jesus? If so, the first step is to understand what the blood of Jesus purchased for us. *"Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful"* (Hebrews 10:19-23) His blood brings us into fellowship with God: We gain bold access to God in worship and prayer. The Bible is clear that every person is alienated and separated from God because of our sin.(Colossians 1:21) That means even the best of us are actually unable to approach God to offer worship or prayer. Because of our sins, we remain at a distance from Him. We can only come to God on His peace terms—the blood atonement. The Bible says "And, having made peace through the blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself..." (Colossians 1:20) "We have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus" "Now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been made near by the blood of Christ" (Ephesians 2:13). It is because of the blood of Jesus Christ that we have the great privilege of pouring our hearts out to God (Psalm 62:8) Praise God for the blood of His Lamb!

His blood makes forgiveness of sin: In addition to being able to enter into God's presence through the blood of Christ, we are also forgiven of our sins. Ephesians 1:7 says that, "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace." Because of Christ's shed blood, God is able to forgive us for our sins and give the punishment that we deserved to Christ. Jesus said, "For this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins" (Matthew 26:28). He was telling His disciples that just as the blood of the lamb delivered the Israelites from the night in Egypt, so Christ's own blood would deliver the people who were covered by it from the judgment of God on the last day.

His blood cleanses Consciences: Through the blood of Christ, we receive the cleansing of consciences. Hebrews 9:14 says, "...how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God." By the blood of Christ, because on the cross He offered Himself unblemished to God! He offered Himself—perfect life—as a sacrifice to God for us on account of our sins. Therefore, He alone is able to cleanse our consciences through His blood. Christ cleansing our consciences from acts that lead to death! We are able to live right lives and think right thoughts once again in Christ. This is great news for those who are burdened by a sinful past and corrupted consciences.

His blood sanctify: Not only are we forgiven from sin, we are also sanctified through the blood of Christ. Hebrews 13:12 tells us that *"Jesus also suffered...in order to sanctify the people through his own blood"* God is calling his people be holy as He is, which is one of the reasons Jesus suffered. *"Without holiness, no one will see the Lord"* (Hebrews 12:14). After we are forgiven of our sins and able to enter into a new relationship with God, it makes sense that God wants us to be in a new relationship with the sin that previously condemned us as well. He gives us the power, through the blood of His Son, to be cleansed from our sinful behaviors.

Use the authority: The devil wants to rob us of our redemptive rights by placing curses of poverty, sickness and death upon our lives. but, we have been redeemed (rescued) from the curse of the law through the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. Revelation 12:11 says, *"And they overcame him (satan) by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony" for they loved not their lives even unto death.*" Satan and his demons are out to destroy us but we can defend ourselves, our families and our possessions with the precious Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. We have victory over evil because Jesus shed His blood on the cross. Remember, the devil was defeated at the cross. Luke 10:19 says *"...I have given you authority over all the power of the enemy..."* Use that authority; use the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ against the enemy. His blood gives power over the devil: We are able to conquer the accuser of the brethren. Because of Christ's sacrifice and the pouring out of His blood on our behalf, we can trust in the righteousness of Christ and not our own righteousness when we are accused by our enemy. It's the blood that Satan fears. As believers, we know that we cannot stand on our own merit or because of our own deeds, and that the Christ's righteousness attributed to us is how we are able to stand up against accusations.

“There must be a personal application of the blood of Christ in order to stem the tide of spiritual destruction in the life of the child of God... It is a personal matter. *'The blood shall be to you for a token. When I see the blood, I will pass over you.'* (Exodus 12:13). The blood, applied by sprinkling, was all that was required for peace of mind and rest of heart. It took away all fear of the destroying angel. There is power in the blood; its worth that availed. It was the applied blood that counted. So it is with the blood of the Lord Jesus. It is effective against satanic floods when applied by faith. A proper application of His blood to a given situation, if the believer is operating from a cleansed position, always brings deliverance. It never fails...”

But Christ has rescued us from the curse pronounced by the law. When he was hung on the cross, he took upon himself the curse for our wrongdoing. For it is written in the Scriptures, “Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree.” Through Christ Jesus, God has blessed the Gentiles with the same blessing he promised to Abraham, so that we who are believers might receive the promised Holy Spirit through faith.”(Galatians 3:13-14) So how do you apply the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ to your situation? By faith. In prayer and in faith you can plead the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ over you and your family, your home, (demonic attacks against people in their homes have been completely stopped by applying the Blood of Jesus throughout the home - doors, windows, etc.). You can draw a blood line of protection around your property, your vehicles, your children’s schools, and your workplace with the precious Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. Remember, the devil cannot penetrate the blood line!

Thank God For The Blood

His blood redeems us - Rescued out of a sinful way of life "...you were redeemed...with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot."(1 Peter 1:18-19) We are rescued from a life lived devoid of meaning and are brought into a relationship with God and the ability to live in his will and with purpose. The blood of Jesus gives us salvation of their souls, forgiveness from sins, access to God, victory over the enemy, and the power to live with a clear conscience. The story of redemption begins in Eden with God shedding the blood of a lamb to cover Adam's and Eve's sin, and ends in heaven. “And they sang a new song, saying: “You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to God by Your blood, Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,(Revelation 5:9)

The blood of Jesus Christ represents two things: (1) The cost of your sin. (2) The cure for your sin. Your salvation wasn't a joint effort. You didn't contribute a penny because you were spiritually bankrupt. ‘...you were redeemed [bought out of slavery and set free]...with the precious blood of Christ’

The preaching of the blood will offend those with sins to hide, a moralistic ego to protect, or a gospel that offers salvation through good works. The blood of Jesus not only saves the repentant but also condemns the defiant, for ‘...without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.’(Hebrews 9:22) Plagues and apocalyptic hail could not release God's people from the Pharaoh. What did? The blood. And the blood has never lost its power. It can (a) heal your painful memories (b) cleanse and set you free from the sin you dare not speak of (c) put a shelter of protection over you, and (d) draw a line in the sand over which the enemy dare not step. Today, thank God for the blood!

Speak out the following declarations over you and your family.

Thank you, Father for the precious Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. Thank you that there is power in the blood, there is salvation in the blood and there is protection in the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ from the deception of satan and his demons. I am redeemed out of the hand of the devil by the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. All my sins are forgiven through the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. I am sanctified, made holy and set apart to God through the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. My body is a temple of the Holy Spirit. Redeemed and cleansed through the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ, satan has no place in me and no power over me.

I apply the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ to my eyes so that I might see into the Spirit realm clearly and with clarity.

I apply the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ to my eyes, to cleanse them of any defilement, wickedness I have watched that is not of You.

I apply the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ to my ears; to cleanse my ears of any defilement, wickedness, gossip or slander that I have listened to, so that I might hear clearly what the Lord is saying to me.

I apply the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ to my lips and to my tongue, so that You, Lord, will be able to cleanse me of those things that I have spoken that really haven't been of You at all.

I apply the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ to my heart and my mind. Since my heart is the creation center of the soul that produces all the emotions and thoughts, I ask You, Lord, to put the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ on my heart, my thoughts, my emotions and cleanse my mind so that I may serve You.

I apply the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ to my feet. Cleanse me from the corruption of this world. Cleanse me of those places in which I have walked that really haven't been ordered of You. Lord, I receive the words of the Bible that say "The steps of a righteous man are ordered by the Lord." I will have holy steps, walking on that highway of holiness. Praise you Lord, and I ask that you cleanse me from the top of my head to the soles of my feet with the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. Read Psalm 91

By pleading the blood of Jesus in prayer, we have seen relationships healed, physical needs provided, finances protected, and many other things. Jesus' blood purchased and total oneness with God, His adopted children. That blood made a way for us to know God, to dwell with Him, to abide in Christ Jesus, and to receive everything our Father has so that His will can be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Jesus poured out His blood on the cross, which is our victory. Here are two short, sample prayers to use as a model when you begin pleading the blood of Jesus.

1. Praying for your finances:

Heavenly Father, I come before You in Jesus' name. Father God, thank You that Jesus died for me to have complete and total access to You. Father, You are my Provider. So Father, in Jesus' name, I am asking that You provide abundantly for my needs today. (Describe your specific needs.) Your word says that You shall supply all my needs according to Your riches in glory in Christ Jesus, and those riches in Jesus go beyond anything I could imagine. So Lord, thank You for performing Your Word. I present the blood of Jesus to You that I can receive everything You've promised, and I plead Jesus' blood over my finances. Thank You, Father God, for providing all my needs, and thank You for being my Father who provides for me. Thank You for the blood of Jesus. In His precious name I pray. Amen.

2. Praying for your health:

Heavenly Father, I come before You in Jesus' name. Father God, thank You that Your Word says I should prosper and be in health, even as my soul prospers. Thank You that Your Word says I am healed by the stripes of Jesus, and that You sent Your Word, Jesus, and healed my disease. Father God, because of the blood Jesus shed on Calvary—that same blood that made a way for me to approach You and receive forgiveness for all of my sins—and because of the terrible, bloody scourging Jesus endured to purchase my healing, I ask that You would heal my body. Let Your healing power course through my veins right now, and heal me from the top of my head to the soles of my feet. Lord Jesus, because You paid the price with Your blood and body for me to be healed, please make my body come into the perfect healing You paid for me to have. Let my brain think right in every area. Let my organs function perfectly. Let my blood be full of the right things. Remove every invading germ, virus, bacteria, malfunction, and malignant cell from my body, and restore any damage done to my body by past sicknesses. Thank You, Father. Thank You that these things are done for me by the blood of Jesus. I receive Your healing right now, and I give You all the glory and praise. In Jesus' name. Amen.
