

PRIVACY POLICY (Updated May 2018)

At Aviation Logic Limited, we are committed to protecting the privacy of site visitors, partners, and customers. We will not sell your personal information to anyone. The information you give us as part of any registration will be processed by us in the UK.

The purpose of this policy is to explain the types of information we obtain from users through the Aviation Logic web site and our apps (www.aviationlogic.com or "Site"), how the information is obtained, how it is used, how it may be obtained by others, and how its use and disclosure can be restricted.

User Consent

By submitting personal information through our Site or Services, you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy and you expressly consent to the collection, use and disclosure of your personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

General Data Collection

When you visit our Site, we may collect or ask you to provide certain information in order to help us manage our relationship with you. This information may include:

- Contact details, such as name, mailing address, email address and phone number;
- Information you provide to us to receive technical assistance or during customer service interactions;
- Information about other people that you may provide with any program or services;
- Information about your computer or device, including browser type and settings, IP address and traffic data relating to your Internet connection;
- Aviation Logic product performance data and information about how you use our products and service
- Aggregated data or other information that does not specifically identify you, such as actions taken on our site.

Information Requests

Aviation Logic requests personal information from you in order to gather your contact information, such as name, company name, address, number, email address, and postal code. Some of this information is optional and you may choose not to provide it. We do not intentionally gather personal information from visitors who are under the age of 13 and a child under 13 should only submit personal information to Aviation Logic with parental/guardian consent. Aviation Logic may use the information to contact you to further discuss your interest in our company and products, to send information regarding product updates and surveys, and to send a newsletter.

Opting Out

You can opt out of being further contacted by Aviation Logic Limited, or receiving further information from us by emailing us at info@aviaionlogic.com with the words 'opt out' in the subject matter. Except as stated in this policy or as provided in a separate Aviation Logic license, we not disclose your personal information to any third party.

By visiting the Site and providing us with data, you acknowledge and agree that your personal information may be processed for the purposes identified in the Privacy Policy.

What We Share

Aviation Logic will not sell your individual information to any third parties. We do not disclose your personal information to third parties, except as set forth in this policy and in cases where we, acting in good faith, believes that such action is necessary to:

- 1) conform to legal requirements or comply with a legal process, such as a search warrant, subpoena, or court order;

- 2) protect and defend the rights or property of Aviation Logic; or
- 3) enforce our license or services agreement(s).

Aviation Logic Limited may share your personal information with third party service providers to:

- provide you with the services that Aviation Logic offers you through our Site;
- to conduct quality assurance testing;
- to facilitate creation of accounts;
- to provide technical support;
- and/ or to provide other services to the Company.

However, if you have an independent relationship with these service providers their privacy statements will apply.

In the process of continuing to develop our business, we may choose to buy or sell certain assets. As a result of these transactions, customer information is usually one of the business assets that is transferred. If Aviation Logic Limited is acquired or a substantial portion of our assets are sold, or if Aviation Logic Limited were to go out of business, enter bankruptcy proceedings or experience some other change in control, your information may be part of the assets which are acquired by or transferred to a third party. We will notify you of any such situation and outline your choices in that event.

Solicitation

By registering at this site, you are authorizing Aviation Logic Limited to email you requested documents, a periodic newsletter, and occasional invitations to attend Aviation Logic and/or our partners' activities. We will not send you any unsolicited information, including email, if at any time you decide to opt-out of receiving such information. If you subsequently registered at this site, and decide again you would like to opt-out of receiving such information, you will need to send a new email to us at info@aviaionlogic.com with the word 'opt out' in the subject matter. However, under certain circumstances, we may be required to send customers updated information about our products.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit or certain emails you open. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide business and marketing information to the owners of the site. Cookies also enable a web site to tailor information presented to you based on your browsing preferences, such as language and geographical region. What types of Cookies are used by Aviation Logic Limited?

The cookies used on this Site are described according to the following cookie categories:

Strictly Necessary. These cookies do not collect any information about you that could be used for marketing purposes or to track your navigation on other websites.

Performance. These cookies do not collect any information about you that could be used for marketing purposes, to track your navigation on other websites, or to send you targeted ads. These cookies collect information about how visitors use our website, for instance which pages they go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies don't collect information that identifies you.

Functionality. We do not use functionality cookies to target you with advertisements on other websites. These cookies allow the website to detect some features of your device, for instance if you are using a mobile to navigate, and to remember choices you make (such as your user name, language or region you are in) and provide enhanced, more personal features. These cookies can be used to remember changes made to text size, fonts and other parts of web

pages that can be customized. They may also be used to provide services you asked for such as watching a video, initiating a chat, or commenting on a blog. These cookies cannot track browsing activity on other websites.

Targeting Cookies. Targeting cookies on our sites are linked to services provided by third parties. Our third party provides these services in return for recognising that you have visited our website. When a visitor comes to the Aviation Logic website for the first time, they are presented with a flag on the webpage indicating that the Aviation Logic website uses cookies. You are requested to click the box to accept the use of cookies on the Aviation Logic website. By continuing to use the website after this flag without expressly accepting the use of cookies by clicking the box to accept, it is implied or deemed that you have given consent to cookies being used.

Privacy Statement.

We have enabled the Demographics and Interest Reporting feature of Google Analytics to collect demographic and interest information about our visitors. Google Analytics uses cookies to collect information such as how often users visit the Site, what pages they visit, and what other sites they used prior to coming to the Site. We use the information we get from Google Analytics only to improve our Site and Services. Google Analytics collects only the IP address assigned to you on the date you visit the Site, rather than your name or other personally identifying information. We do not combine the information generated through the use of Google Analytics with your personal information. Although Google Analytics plants a persistent cookie on your web browser to identify you as a unique user the next time you visit the Site, the cookie cannot be used by anyone but Google. Google's ability to use and share information collected by Google Analytics about your visits to the Site is restricted by the Google Analytics Terms of Use and the Google Privacy Policy.

You can opt out from any of these cookies by adjusting your browser settings to reject cookies. If you have previously visited our websites, you may also have to delete any existing cookies from your browser.

Many of our cookies are functionality cookies and some of these cookies are managed for us by third parties. You can control the use of these cookies through your browser settings, but if you opt out from them, we may be unable to offer some services or support and we may also be unable to remember your preferences or that you did not want a certain service.

Is my personal information secure?

The personal information collected by Aviation Logic is stored in secure operating environments that are not available to the general public. However, no data transmission over the Internet, electronic communication between parties, or networks and associated storage available over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. Consequently, while we strive to protect your personal information, Aviation Logic cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information you transmit to us.
