

United Kingdom and Canada have signed a Protocol and an Interpretative Protocol to their existing DTA

(July 21, 2014)

On July 21, 2014 the UK and Canada signed a Protocol and an Interpretative Protocol to their existing Double Taxation Convention. These Protocols a.o. update the treaty articles on: business profits, dividends, interest, royalties, the mutual agreement procedure, exchange of information and assistance in the collection of taxes.

The Protocols will enter into force once both countries have completed their legislative procedures.
