

Hunter Ash Memorial Scholarship for Fine Arts

Eligibility:

1. Applicants must be a current member in the Magnolia Fine Arts. Theater, Choir, Dance, Art, and Band are considered Fine Arts.
2. Applicants must have a 3.0 GPA or higher.
3. Typed applications are strongly encouraged. Handwritten applications will only be considered if in blue or black ink and printed legibly. Any application written in pencil will be automatically disqualified.

How are winners selected?

The Scholarship Committee will select scholarship recipients. Among matters considered will be high school academic records, participation in the MHS Fine Arts program, extra-curricular activities; leadership qualities, and the students' own statements and answers to the questions on the application.

Applicants must carefully follow the application instructions. If any part of the application is incomplete, it will be rejected.

When to apply?

Scholarship applications may be obtained from the Magnolia High School College and Career Center (The U). Keep in mind; the scholarship application must be on file with the Magnolia Fine Arts Department via Mrs. Herzog no later than **May 10, 2019 no later than 2:30 PM**.

How to apply?

1. Applications may be obtained from the Magnolia High School Guidance Counselor or the Magnolia Fine Arts Department
2. Applicant will need to have their Counselor enter current rank in class, current class size, community service hours on file, and certify with his/her signature.
3. Once the application has been completed you must return all the required information into **Mrs. Herzog on or before May 10, 2019 no later than 2:30 PM** at Magnolia High School.
4. Applications will be forwarded to the Scholarship Committee for review. The Committee chair will place applicants' answers only in an envelope with an application number. The Committee Chair will keep first page with applicant's name and application number. This insures applicants stay anonymous through the process.

NOTE: All applications must be received by Mrs. Herzog on or before May 10, 2019 no later than 2:30 PM of the applicant's senior year in high school. Applications received after that date will not be considered. Applicants may undergo interviews by the Scholarship Committee for final selection of scholarship winners if deemed necessary. Scholarship recipients will be announced in May at the Senior awards.
