WASHINGTON PALM

Scientific Name: Washingtonia robusta

Approximate Height: 80 ft Width: 10 – 15 ft

Growth Pattern: Single, straight, slender, pale gray trunk, tapered from a stout base, often covered with

old leaves and boots. Close, compact head. Propagation: seeds.

Description: Leaves palmate, armed, bright green, to about 5 ft wide, with drooping tips. Petoiles

reddish brown about 3 ft long, with spines on margins especially when young.

Soil and Moisture: Tolerant of most soils. Prefers moderately good, well-drained soil.

pH Preference: 5.0 – 7.0 Salt Tolerance: Fair Freezes at about: 20 F
