## CHRISTIAN COUNSELLING COURSES

The Manna House Counselling Service in Northampton are running an OCN recognised course at level 2. The course is called 'Introduction to Christian Counselling' and will run on Thursdays from 7pm - 10pm for 12 weeks, starting on Thursday 4th April 2019. The total cost for this course is £225.

They are also running a level 4 course called 'Diploma in Christian Counselling' which will run on Tuesday evenings from 6.15pm - 10.15pm for 2 years, starting on Tuesday 30th April 2019. It will also include 8 Saturdays per year. The total cost for this course is £2500 but it can be paid in installments.
