MEMO FROM PASTOR MICHAEL: ORDINARY TIME

The Christian year divides neatly into two halves. From Advent through Pentecost is 26 weeks. It includes the really big Holy Days of the church; Christmas, Epiphany, Holy Week and Easter. This period focuses on the incarnation and resurrection of Jesus. The second period is also 26 weeks and focuses on the life of the church.

This second half began on Trinity Sunday, May 26, 2024. This second period has had a number of titles in my lifetime. As a youngster the church I grew up in called it "Trinity," and later, "Kingdomtide." The Lutherans call it "the season after Pentecost" and number the Sundays. Another portion of the Christian church, including the Catholic Church calls it "ordinary time." I like that. Not everything can be special all the time. We need the ordinary to set off the special.

During this ordinary time the focus is on the life of the church and once every three years the lectionary provides an option that is a simi-continuous reading of the books of Samuel, Kings and Chronicles. And in June, July and August we will be reading this narrative of history that I think of as the nation building phase of the saga of those who follow the God Yahweh. This summer the life of the church is about the life of a nation.

So here is a schedule of the preaching in June:

June 2 "Samuel' Call" 1 Samuel 3:1-20

June 9 "Saul Becomes King" 1 Samuel 8:4-20, 11:14-15

June 16 "Samuel Anoints David" 1 Samuel 15:34 – 16:13

June 23 "David and Goliath" 1 Samuel 17:14-11, 19-23, 32-49

June 30 "Elegy for Saul" 2 Samuel 1:1, 17-27

These are all wonderful oral stories full of action, faith in God, and human character patterns that hold recognizable over the centuries! I enjoy preaching and have never been able to do a series quite like this before. Young Abe Lincoln was so poor as a boy that the only book his family owned was a Bible. He could have done far worse than reading Samuel and Kings in preparation for the presidency!

If you want some homework you can read the whole of 1 Samuel; there are many great accounts that are not scheduled for reading in church. And such reading would help show how these narratives fit together.
