



Westar Energy has announced a planned electric outage to make necessary repairs at the Moran substation. This outage will affect all City of Moran customers. Please be prepared to be without electric service on Thursday, August 1<sup>st</sup> from 11:00 PM to 5:00 AM on Friday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>. This work is being done to prevent any future unplanned outages and repairs. If you plan to use a generator during the service interruption, you must isolate your generator from Moran's electrical system. Failure to do so will not only damage your generator, but can cause serious injury to city personnel.

## **Preparing for a Planned Electric Outage**

- If you have medical support equipment that is dependent on electricity, be ready with your back-up plan to maintain the use of your equipment.
- Have flashlights with fresh batteries handy.
- Minimize the opening of refrigerator and freezer doors to maintain temperature.
- Shut off or disconnect all sensitive equipment, such as computers, fax machines, televisions, microwaves, etc. before the outage begins.
- Turn off any major appliances like washers or air conditioners prior to the outage. This will prevent them from unexpectedly coming on when the power is restored.
- Notify your alarm and phone company as alarm phone systems can be affected.
- Make sure you know how to override or manually operate your security gates or garage doors.
