This coming week, February 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>, I will be gone for my annual retreat. I have been going to a conference center associated with Opus Dei (Latin for the Work of God) for my annual retreat. If any emergency should arise please contact Rev. Randy Phillips in Scotland. The office number for the parish is: 605-583-4318. I will have my cell phone with me in case of something that requires my attention. Please pray for me and I will do the same for you.

Now that I have been the pastor of Saint Wenceslaus and Saint John the Baptist parishes for a little over six months, there are some observations that I wish to share with you and provide some suggestions for us to consider. I will take this weekend's bulletin and next weekend's bulletin to address some of these things. Since this bulletin covers both parishes these remarks will be very general and I may offer more specific comments to each parish in a different way.

The first observation that I would like to offer is the tremendous response we get when we have a funeral at either parish. Since moving here, I have celebrated several funerals and the assistance from the altar societies and other volunteers has helped each family who has lost a loved one. Another thing about our communities is the perseverance you have shown throughout some difficult weather. I know that all of you are not farmers but much of our area is rooted in tending to the fields and livestock. You have taught me a lot about what it means to trust in God's plan even when it is very difficult to do so. Another observation is this: I am very thankful to each of you for the ways in which you have welcomed me into your communities and homes. May God bless your hospitality and desire to grow in your relationship with Jesus.

Another observation comes from my time in smaller towns and parishes is that word travels fast. When I lived in Garretson, I had a couple of fender benders with a raccoon, a small deer, and someone else's car. The Highway Patrol stopped at the rectory each time this happened and people then wondered what's going on at the rectory? There can be a healthy sense of watching out for our friends and neighbors but there can also be an unhealthy sense of watching out for friends and neighbors as well. What I am getting at is that each of us deserves our privacy. We all deal with stress and difficult situations in different ways and we feel comfortable talking about it with certain people. Gossip can do harm to other people's and our own reputation. I am not saying that gossip is rampant in our parishes but from time to time it comes about and I offer the following story to help us understand what gossip can do. Saint Philip Neri is a saint that lived in Italy and one day while hearing confessions, someone confessed the sin of gossip. For a penance, he asked the person to take a feather pillow to the top of church steeple, cut open the pillow, let the feathers fly, and then come back to him to complete the penance. The person went back to Saint Philip Neri and then they were asked to go find and pick up all of the feathers. Obviously this would be an impossible task but it makes the point of what happens to gossip when it leaves our mouths and we have no idea where it may travel and how it may get exaggerated.

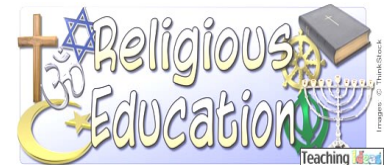
