Dear Brothers and Sisters: From Catechism: The Mass is the Source and Summit of the Christian Life: continuation of the Mass from the official Roman Missal(on Altar): The action of the Priest (in Red) and the People (In Black,) at Mass: (people's response in bold, my notes in italic) The Liturgy of the **Eucharist:** Continued:

....so that it may become for us the Body and Blood of your most beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ. He joins his hands. In the formulas that follow, the words of the Lord should be pronounced clearly and distinctly, as the nature of these words requires. On the day before he was to suffer The Priest takes the bread and, holding it slightly raised above the altar, continues: he took bread in his holy and venerable hands, He raises his eyes. and with eyes raised to heaven to you, O God, his almighty Father, giving you thanks he said the blessing, broke the bread and gave it to his disciples, saying: He bows slightly. TAKE THIS, ALL OF YOU, AND EAT OF IT, FOR THIS IS MY BODY, WHICH WILL BE GIVEN UP FOR YOU. He shows the consecrated host to the people, places it again on the paten, and genuflects in adoration. After this, the Priest continues: In a similar way, when supper was ended, He takes the chalice and, holding it slightly raised above the altar, continues: he took this precious chalice in his holy and venerable hands, and once more giving you thanks, he said the blessing and gave the chalice to his disciples, saying: (to be continued:) God Bless Fr. Grace


