



Asylum: Out of the Shadows explores the history of how society has cared for those with mental illnesses through the lens of the Outagamie County Asylum. The exhibit is a perfect fit for psychology classes at the high school and college level to explore the long history mental health facilities in the United States.

What does the tour include?

A visit to the exhibit includes a short guided portion, time to explore the exhibit, and a worksheet of discussion question that instructors may use however they wish.

Cellphone Tour Option

For an added layer, have your students download the free accompanying smartphone app audio tour, available for Android and iPhones in the app store.

Pick from eight characters who guide you through the exhibit and tell you about their experiences at the asylum. Each character is a narrative based on a real people who lived or worked at the asylum. Each tour takes about half an hour. Please bring earbuds.
