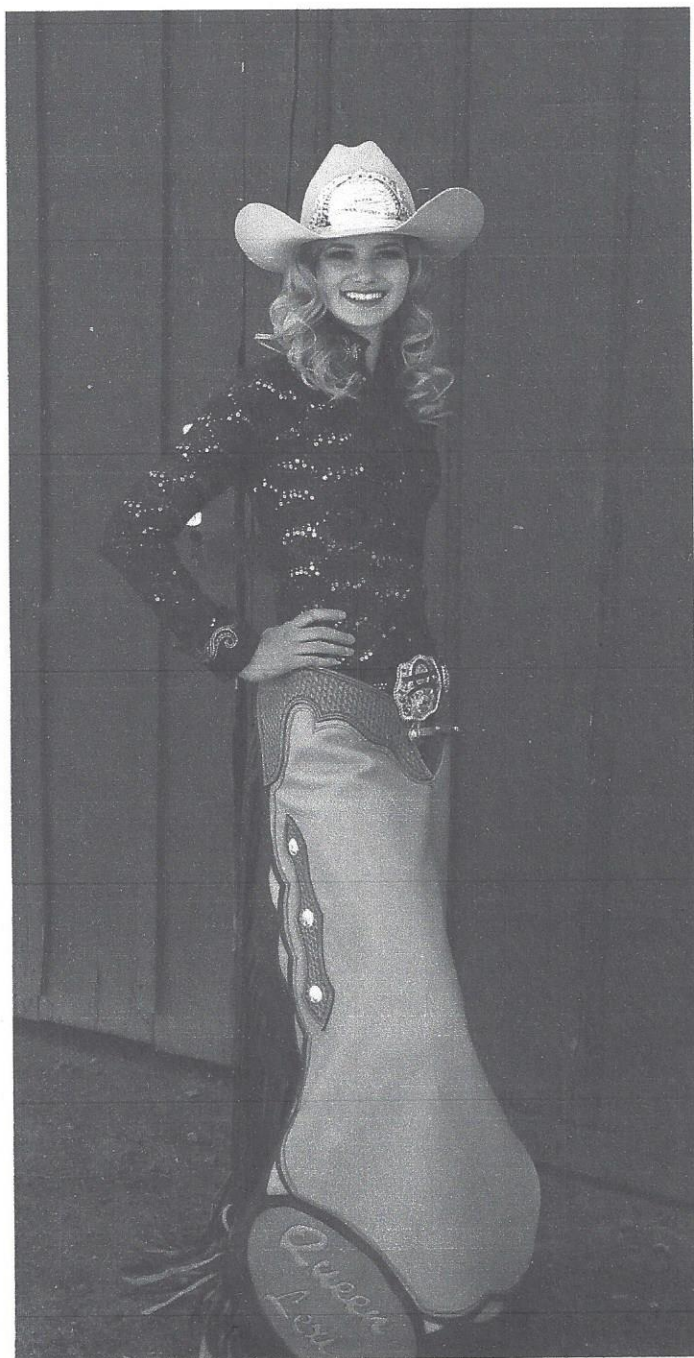


2017 SHERMAN COUNTY FAIR
