About Matt

Matt became a Rocklin Police Officer in 2001. He was dedicated to keeping our community a safe place for all of us to live. Matt was a firearms instructor for his department and a member of the Rocklin/Roseville SWAT Team.

He specialized in drug and alcohol detection. Matt was the recipient of the MADD Award in 2004 for having the most



DUI arrests in Placer County. He was also the recipient of the Life Saving Award and the Bronze Medal of Honor.

Matt loved his job, his family, and the community he grew up in. He worked hard and was an extremely focused and dedicated officer whose efforts had a positive impact on an entire community.

Matt gave his life while dutifully serving the community of Rocklin when he was tragically and fatally injured by a drunk hit and run driver on October 9, 2005 on highway 65, closing the lanes to assure the safety of other officers further up the road who were conducting a felony traffic stop. His death has created a void in our lives that cannot be filled.

The Start of the Foundation

As Matt's parents, John and Marilyn Redding, we wanted to keep Matt's name alive in this community by doing good things. The concept of this Foundation started the week of October 9, 2005 by personal donations and has continued by fundraiser and donations since Matt's death.
