

Second Sunday after Epiphany REFLECTIONS

Grace...Heaven is a free gift

"The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." (Romans 6:23) We cannot earn our way to heaven and none of us really deserve to go. It is a gift.

Man...We are all sinners

"All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23) Every person who has ever lived has missed God's standard of perfection.

God...He loves us

"God is love." (1 John 4:8) While God loves us and doesn't want to punish us, we should also know that he is a just God, He must punish sin. "The soul who sins shall die." (Ezekiel 18:4)

Christ...God balanced justice and love through His son Jesus

Jesus is the infinite God-man, God in the flesh. He died on the cross and rose from the dead to pay the penalty for our sins and to purchase a place for us in haven, which he offers as a free gift.

Faith...The gift of eternal life is received by faith.
