A cursory analysis of the statistical data from this report should be demonstrative of the quality of performance of this agency in realizing the contractual obligations and the overall achievement of the goals and objectives of this Agency and the Toll Road Division.

A total of 320 man-hours was scheduled; 232 man-hours were actual dedicated to patrol functions. hours were exhausted on vacation time, workers compensatory, and COVID sick leave. 1179 total miles were driven and the shift responded to 419 total service calls. The shift issued 9 traffic warnings, made 1 arrests and handled 13 enforcement service-related calls. The average productivity ratio for this month for this shift is 3.1

Deputy Rodriguez contracted COVID and was out for a portion of the month* The contract supervisor along with patrol and West Bellfort deputies covered his shift during this time.



Security Checks Percentages and Trends










