PADDLE + PEDDLE

Participants meet at Camp Guyasuta and hike five minutes to a marina in Sharpsburg. Once there, you are given instruction on paddling and paired with a partner. Participants canoe from Sharpsburg to Millvale or PNC Park and then bike back to Camp Guyasuta along the river front trail.

- + Guided by Camp Guyasuta staff
- + Safety pontoon boat follows kayaks
- + Truck chase crew follows along the trek
- + Bag lunch can be provided for an additional fee
- + Life jackets, paddles, kayaks, and bikes are provided
- + Helmets are available if you do not have your own
- + Round-trip to PNC Park takes about five hours

This program runs from May – October.

Camp Guyasuta's Corporate Team Building Programs are presented in three parts to incorporate teamwork, communication, trust, leadership, problem solving, self-esteem, conflict resolution, and fun!



1 INITIATIVE GAMES

Our highly trained facilitators divide the groups up into approximately 12 people per group and begin with initiative games designed to break the ice and set goals for the day. Each initiative game challenges the teams to “think outside the box” and utilize mental, rather than physical, strengths.

2 LOW COURSE

Once teams have advanced through our initiative games, they will proceed to the low challenge course. On our low course, groups use maneuvers and skills learned during Step 1 to advance through 14 low challenge elements. As always, safety, teamwork, and communication are stressed throughout all activities.

3 HIGH COURSE

Once teams have completed the initiative games and low course they advance onto our high ropes course. On this course everything is “challenge by choice,” however, we challenge everyone to take one step more than they typically would take. We have 14 different high elements, complete with climbing wall, rappelling, and a 700-foot zip line!
