## SUMMER SCHEDULE

Over the past 2 weeks several members of our girls and boys competitive gymnastics teams have competed in the USAG state meets and a few have qualified to the Regional Championships. ## **Crowded Parking Lot**

We know that the parking lot situation is creating a lot of frustration and we are working to remedy the issues. The landlord is planning to repair the potholes once the weather breaks and we are beyond any freezing issues (mid to late April). Another solution we have developed is that we are altering the class times on Wednesday night to allow the lot to empty between the 5 and 6 PM classes. Several of the 5:15 classes have been moved to 5 PM. We have also repaired several of the lights in the parking area.

Remember that at no time may a car obstruct the flow of traffic in and out of the lot (there must always be room for two cars to move into and out of the entrance to the parking lot simultaneously). We will be forced to call a towing company and remove (at the owner's expense) any car which is placed in a position that impedes safe traffic flow. Those who parallel park near the sidewalk entrance must "hug" the area near the grass to allow enough room for two cars to pass. Thank you for helping us keep a safe zone for all our members by moving through the parking area slowly (under 15 miles per hour).
