



Anchor Scholarship Foundation Eligibility Criteria

Our Scholarships fall into *two categories* of Eligibility Criteria:

FOUNDATION SCHOLAR

- ❑ Dependent child or spouse of a US Navy sailor (active, retired, honorably discharged), now referred to as Sponsor.
- ❑ Sponsor *must have* a Surface Warfare qualification (SWO/ESWS) *and* served 6 years (active duty) in commands under the administrative control of Commander Naval Surface Forces, US Atlantic Fleet (COMNAVSURFLANT) and/or US Pacific Fleet (COMNAVSURFOR).
 - Sponsors (Officer Only) may utilize service on CVNs toward the 6 year (active duty) requirement.
- ❑ The time requirement is cumulative, assignments need not be consecutive.

Will be considered for:

- Foundation Scholarships - \$2,500 Annuals and \$10,000 4yr Renewable(s) (\$2,500/yr)
- The Raytheon-Zumwalt Scholarship - \$20,000 4yr Renewable (\$5,000/yr)
- T.Nash Broadus DECO Scholarship – Three Annual scholarships, up to \$6,000 each (must be a child dependent of an Active Duty Enlisted US Navy Surface Force Sailor)
- The Leidos STEM Scholarship - \$6,000 Annual
- The RADM James Prout III Memorial Scholarship (additionally, must reside in the San Diego area) - \$5,000 Annual
- The AUSTAL USA STEM Scholarship - \$4,500 Annual (additionally, must reside in the greater Washington DC area, San Diego County or the state of Alabama)
- The Rolls-Royce STEM Scholarship - \$4,500 Annual (availability confirmed in Jan)
- Sumitomo Drive Technologies Engineering Scholarship - \$3,000 Annual (degree requirement and reside in the Hampton Roads Region)
- As well as any Ship's Company scholarships that the student's sponsor meets the qualification for.

SHIP'S COMPANY SCHOLAR

- ❑ Dependent child or spouse of a US Navy sailor (active, retired, honorably discharged), now referred to as Sponsor
- ❑ Sponsor must have been a member of Ship's Company for a minimum of 1 year
 - The USS Bulkeley (DDG 84) Scholarship - \$3,500 Annual
 - The Arleigh Burke Association Scholarship - \$2,250 Annual
 - USS Arleigh Burke (DDG 51)
 - The Arleigh Burke Trust Scholarship - \$2,250 Annual
 - USS Arleigh Burke (DDG 51)
 - The USS Cincinnati (LCS 20) – up to \$8,000 in annual scholarships
 - The USS Thomas Hudner (DDG 116) – two \$4,000 Annual
 - The Billy Hurley III Scholarship - \$2,400 Annual
 - USS Chung-Hoon (DDG 93) or USS Gettysburg (CG 64)
