With concurrence of the members present, the District Meeting of the members of Arizona Republican Legislative District 23, held Via Linda Senior Center was called to order at 6:55 PM

In opening, District Chairman Jim O'Connor welcomed everyone and thanked them for their attendance.

The Invocation was given by Scott Rehmann.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given by Alex Meluskey.

Alex Meluskey spoke for 5 minutes about his campaign.

Second Vice Chairman – Rick Rutkowski told us that our next meeting will be on August 11th and will be held at the Via Linda Senior Center in Scottsdale. David Schweikert and Russ Whittenburg will be the speakers at that meeting.

The speakers were announced for this evenings meeting, Maricopa County Recorder, Helen Purcell who is running for reelection for that office. She explained some of the new innovations in that office and what has been done to be sure that the election difficulties that occurred during the Presidential Preference election will be remedied. She took a short question and answer period. Boe James reminded everyone that poll workers are needed.

Vice Chair Nancy Ordowski stressed the importance of doing the walking lists. She suggested that each PC speak to 150 people. Captains need to distribute the lists to their PC's. We can start walking the last week of July and should be completed by August 13th at the latest because early ballots will be dropped by August 3rd. She explained about the "Golden Tickets" that contain the list of candidates that are being endorsed by LD23. There is a separate card for Fountain Hills whose election is in August

Treasurer, Valerie Giramberk, gave her report that is attached.

Robert Littlefield and Jim Lane were then introduced for the Mayoral Forum. They were given 2 minutes for their opening comments. They participated in an open forum in which questions were directed

to both of the candidates to allow us to compare their answers. They will be allowed 2 minutes to respond. Each candidate was allowed 2 minutes for closing comments,

The minutes of the May 12th meeting were brought up for approval. Corrections were made by Boe James that were accepted and the minutes will be amended to reflect those corrections. A motion was made by Tim Horn to accept the Minutes for the May 12th meeting and was seconded by Wil Berry. The minutes were then passed as amended.
