### *Sunday Meditation*

There are two kinds of faith, both equally noble—achieving faith, which obtains deliverance; and enduring faith, which holds on faithfully when deliverance doesn't come. The former faith overcomes, moves mountains. The latter finds grace to be "sufficient" while the "thorn in the flesh" remains. After celebrating the achieving faith of many Old Testament heroes in the first part of Hebrews 11, the writer speaks of "others" who were *not* delivered. The former victoriously "*stopped the mouth of lions, quenched the power of fire, escaped the edge of the sword.*" We happily recall those victors who were delivered, but give less regard to those who weren't delivered, "*who experienced mocking and scourging...chains and imprisonment; they went about in sheepskins and goatskins, being destitute, afflicted, ill-treated*" and much more. But it is of these latter, and not the former, of which the writer declares: "*the world is not worthy of them.*" All for Jesus, Richard
