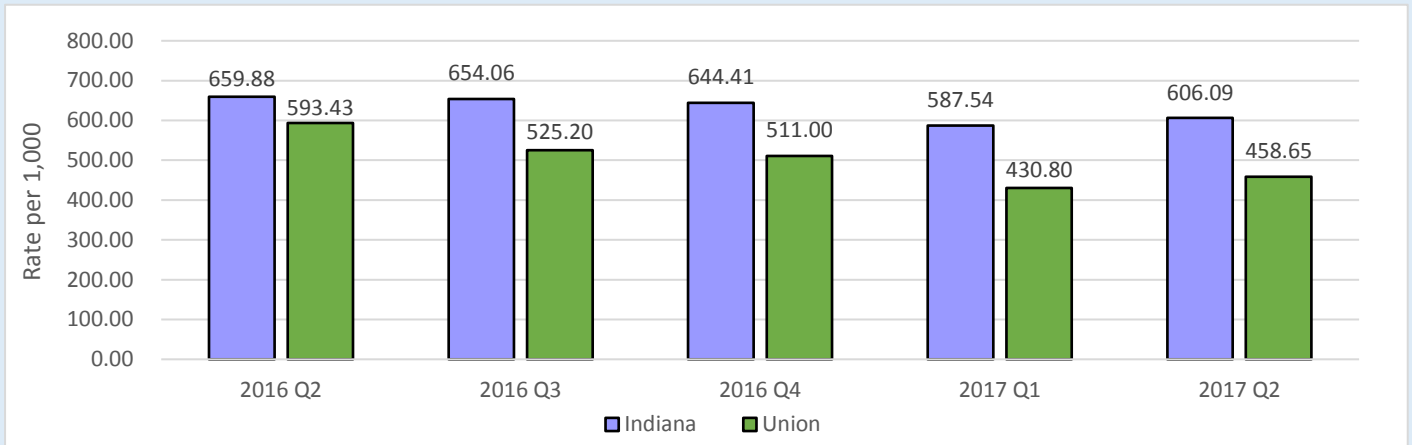

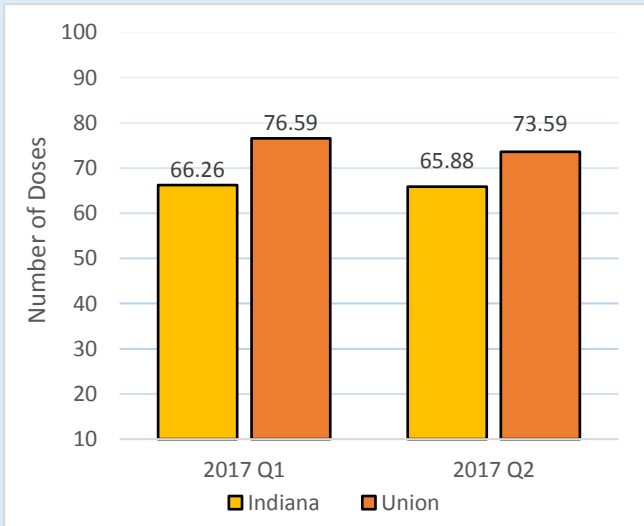

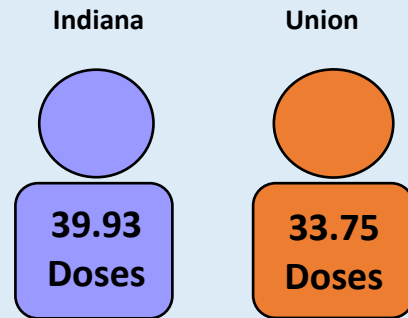

On average each person in Union County received **33.75 doses** of prescribed controlled substances during 2017 quarter 2, which is **lower** than the **Indiana** state average of **39.93** doses.

Data Notes

Prescription (Rx)= instruction written by a medical practitioner that authorizes a patient to be provided a medicine or treatment.
 Dose = a quantity of a medicine or drug taken or recommended to be taken at a particular time.
 Population from 2015 census data.

Limitations

Rates are not adjusted by age or terminal illness diagnoses. Data are based upon the location of the pharmacy where the prescription is filled. This may or may not be where the prescription is written or where the individual receiving the prescription resides.
