Reminders

When posting scores on the computer, make sure that you are making adjustments in accordance with the USGA's Equitable Stroke Control procedures. Equitable Stroke Control sets a maximum number that a player can post on any hole. The following table shows the maximum score you can post on any hole contingent on your handicap.

Course Handicap	Maximum Number Posted on Any Hole
9 or less	Double Bogey
10 – 19	7
20 – 29	8
30 – 39	9
40 or more	10
