WARREN COUNTY (PEQUEST RIVER) MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

MINUTES May 16, 2023

Chairperson Napolitani called the regular meeting of the Warren County (Pequest River) Municipal Utilities Authority to order at 6:01 p.m. The meeting was held at the Authority's Administration building located at 199 Foul Rift Road, Belvidere, New Jersey.

Roll Call:

Laurel Napolitani, Chairwoman Joseph Roth, Vice Chairperson Gerald Norton, Secretary – arrived at 6:14 p.m. Angelo Accetturo, Treasurer

Also, in attendance: Kim Francisco, Authority CFO; Brian Tipton, Esq., Authority Legal Counsel, John Inscho, Executive Director; and Susan Wright, Administrative Assistant.

Lori Ciesla, Warren County Commissioner, WCPRMUA Liaison, was also present, as well as William Godfrey, Chief Operator J. Wasser and Operator R. Berger from the Oxford WWTP, and Operator M. Berger and Operator B. Snyder from the Belvidere WWTP.

<u>TOUR</u>: At approximately 6:05 p.m., the tour of the Belvidere facility began and concluded at approximately 6:55 p.m. and the meeting continued.

Chairwoman Napolitani led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance and then read the Introductory Statement.

MINUTES

Mr. Accetturo moved, and Mr. Norton seconded to approve the minutes of the April 18, 2023 regular meeting, as presented. All in favor, motion carried.

Mr. Accetturo moved, and Mr. Roth seconded to approve the minutes of the April 18, 2023 executive session, as presented. All in favor, motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE

Mr. Norton recapped the correspondence listed below:

1. Email correspondence dated May 8, 2023 from William Godfrey advising the Board of his resignation as Commissioner effective immediately.

2. Notice from Ricciuti Enterprises, LLC, to the White Township Board of Adjustments for the approval of a resolution granting the certification of pre-existing non-conforming use of the property known as Block, 14, Lot 26, located at 577 Brass Castle Road, Township of White, County of Warren, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40-55D-68.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Madison was not in attendance; however, his report was provided to the Commissioners prior to the meeting. Chairwoman Napolitani inquired if there were any questions. There were no questions or comments.

CFO'S REPORT

Mr. Francisco summarized the monthly financial report.

All customers paid on time this quarter.

Mr. Inscho advised that one of the lawnmowers at the Belvidere plant, which was 18 years old, is not working any longer. He has received several prices to replace the lawnmower. Mr. Inscho inquired if the mower can be purchased as a capital expense, and Mr. Francisco agreed.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Mr. Tipton had nothing to report.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Belvidere: Still having issues with the Mechanical Screen.

Clarifier: Will set up a schedule with Alpine to repair the paint on Tank 1 and Tank 3. Denied Alpine's Change Order #5 for the \$47,000.00 for the plug.

OSHA: Still must complete the paving and the sidewalks and then we will be compliant. We have until June 18, 2023 to complete all the work.

The generator for the Belvidere pump station should be in by next week. The transfer switch for Oxford should also be in sometime next week as well.

Oxford: Mr. Inscho advised that a mag meter will be placed on the line coming out of Spring Meadow.

Sludge Tank has been completely repaired.

Still working with Elizabethtown Gas to get natural gas at Belvidere.

AUTHORITY CHAIRWOMAN

Chairwoman Napolitani expressed how the Board will miss Mr. Godfrey. The County will be filling the vacancy.

Chairwoman Napolitani advised the Board that she, Mr. Inscho and Ms. Wright watched a webinar regarding loans and grants for water and wastewater disposal. It was much more focused on loans than grants, which is what we are preliminary interested in. There are a lot of opportunities for grants and will continue to investigate what is available.

Our AllMax software is ready for an upgrade, which is at no cost to the Authority.

Chairwoman Napolitani, once again, opened a discussion regarding continuing healthcare for the two new Operators upon their retirement, which has not been offered since 2015. No formal action has been taken thus far. Mr. Roth suggested that the Board offer it to them from the date of their retirement until Medicare takes over at 65 years of age. Mr. Francisco advised that he will find out the County's criteria for retirement (tiers) and the costs associated with carrying them from retirement age until age 65. Formal action will be taken at next month's meeting.

Mr. Roth moved to approve Resolution #23-16 authorizing the Authority to enter into an Agreement with the North Jersey Wastewater Cooperative Pricing System. Mr. Norton seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

FINANCE

Mr. Accetturo moved that Resolution #23-17 (Certificate No. 441: \$65,012.80) be approved to pay all bills from the Operating Fund, as presented. Mr. Roth seconded. All in favor, motion passed.

Mr. Accetturo moved that Resolution #23-18 (Certificate No. 447: \$8,837.82) be approved to pay all bills from the Capital Improvements Fund as presented. Mr. Roth seconded. All in favor, motion passed.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Mr. Accetturo inquired whether the Authority needs to formally request our Engineer to speak on our behalf regarding the pump station/pipeline in White Township at any future meetings with the Township. Mr. Inscho will request an update on this issue with White Township and then reach out to the Engineer.

NEW BUSINESS

Ms. Wright advised the Board that this year July 4th is on a Tuesday and therefore, requested that instead of taking Election Day (November 7th) as a holiday that we be able to take the Monday before (July 3rd) off as well. This is just for 2023. Mr. Roth moved to approve the switch of the

Election Day paid holiday to Monday, July 3, 2023, to those employees that wish to do so. Mr. Norton seconded. All in favor, motion passed.

Mr. Godfrey expressed his appreciation to sit on the Board this year.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At approximately 7:20 p.m., Mr. Roth moved, and Mr. Norton seconded to adopt Resolution #23-19, to enter into an executive session to discuss personnel matters. All in favor, motion passed. Mr. Francisco, Ms. Wright, Mr. Godfrey, County Commissioner Ciesla and the Operators were excused during said executive session.

At 7:44 p.m., Mr. Norton moved, and Mr. Roth seconded to return to open session. All in favor, motion passed.

No action was taken and therefore, no overview was presented.

As there was no more business to come before the Authority, Mr. Roth moved for the meeting to be adjourned. The meeting was adjourned 7:45 p.m.
