August is here, school is starting and fall weather is just around the corner!

We finished a fantastic six weeks of Summer Reading with the theme of Oceans of Possibilities. I want to thank First National Bank for being our long time summer reading sponsor. We were able to use the Heritage Theater each week and have special programs for the community to enjoy. A big thank you also goes to David Crane and David Robertson with TWRA for providing the annual creek walk. Thank you to Dr. Stanton Belford and Dr. Shanna Hanes and UT Southern for providing a great marine biology adult program and for giving us a tour of the science building on campus. And thank you to Pulaski Parks and Recreation for our end of summer reading partnership finale.

Appreciation also goes to our community supporters Colonel Littleton, Daylight Donuts, McDonald's, Reeves Drug Store, and SunDrop, for providing prizes for our summer reading participants. We also appreciate our faithful volunteers - Lydia Ball, Paulette Bledsoe, Elizabeth May and Mason Wells - who did prep work and helped with the programs!

With all the community support, we were able to meet weekly with 7 groups and provide 9 special programs to 1,267 kids, teens and adults who participated in one or more of the forty-two programs offered. We had 122 registered readers who logged 9,879 pages during our six-week program. It was a busy summer, but a great one! A special thanks to Teresa Burns, T'Kayah Mitchell and Elizabeth Roller for their planning and execution of all the great programs provided and all the rest of the staff for taking up the slack when they were providing programs outside the library.

On **August 18<sup>th</sup>**, we are having another **James Webb Space Telescope** event at our **Lynnville Branch** from 3:30-5:00pm. We will be showing the first images from the telescope and doing space related STEM activities. Come join us for a fun afternoon exploring space!

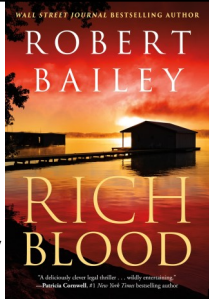

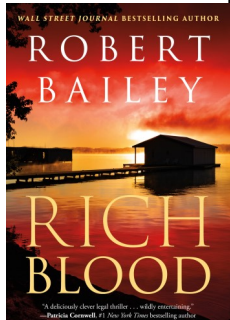
