
### Secondary 1: Elementary

#### **Listening & Speaking**

#### **Reading & Writing**

Students will learn to:

- Introduce themselves and answer basic questions about themselves
- Make and respond to invitations, suggestions, apologies and requests
- Talk briefly about things they have done
- Talk about a problem in simple terms
- Say they do not understand something / cannot do something and ask for help
- Understand audio and video clips
- Understand longer texts about everyday topics, even if they do not know all the words, and can use a dictionary
- Write a short message on a postcard or email
- Write about how they feel, and give reasons why, in simple sentences
- Make up a story in English using ideas, pictures or words the teacher gives them
- Write short dialogues such as in speech bubbles, picture stories or comics

# Learning Objectives

## Secondary Level 2

### Listening & Speaking

### Reading & Writing

Pre – Intermediate Level

Students will learn to:

- Understand simple questions and Instructions
- Express simple opinions or requirements in a familiar context
- Understand straightforward directions, provided that these are not lengthy or complex
- Express likes and dislikes in familiar contexts using simple language
- Understand the general meaning of a presentation made at a conference if the language is simple and backed up by visuals or video
- State simple requirements within own job area
- Understand basic instructions on class times, dates and room numbers
- Express simple opinions using expressions such as "I don't agree"
- Understand straightforward information within a known area
- Complete forms and write short simple letters or postcards related to personal information.
- Understand straightforward information on food, standard menus, road signs and messages on automatic cash machines.
- Complete most forms related to personal information
- Understand most short reports or manuals of a predictable nature within his/her own area of expertise
- Write a short, comprehensible note of request to a colleague or a known contact in another company
- Understand the general meaning of a simplified textbook or article, reading very slowly
- Write a very short simple narrative or description capturing the most important points



### Secondary Level 3 and 4

Students will learn to:

- Understand straightforward instructions or public announcements.
- Express simple opinions on abstract/cultural matters in a limited way or offer advice within a known area.
- Understand the main points of TV programmes on familiar topics.
- Talk about things such as films and music and describe his/her reactions to them.
- Understand instructions on classes and homework given by a teacher or lecturer.
- Repeat back what people say to check that he/she has understood.
- Give detailed practical instructions on how to do something he/she knows well.
- Understand routine information and articles.
- Write letters or make notes on familiar or predictable matters.
- Understand factual articles in magazines and letters from friends expressing personal opinions.
- Write to his/her friends about the books, music and films that he/she likes.
- Understand most information of a factual nature in his/her school subjects.
- Write a description of an event, for example a school trip.
- Take basic notes in a lesson.

# Learning Objectives

Advanced Level


## Listening & Speaking

## Reading & Writing

Upper Intermediate Level 1, 2 and 3

Students will learn to:

- Identify the expression of feelings and attitudes such as criticism, disapproval, agreement, and so on.
- Start, have and end conversations on familiar topics.
- Understand the main points of TV programmes on familiar topics.
- Talk about things such as films and music and describe his/her reactions to them.
- Ask for factual information and understand the answer.
- Ask for clarification and further explanation and will probably understand the answer.
- Express views, feelings, and opinions effectively in writing and give reasons.
- Find relevant information in texts.
- Write e-mails and letters which are more or less formal, according to how well he/she knows the person he/she is writing to (for example to get information he/she needs for a school project or about a social activity).
- Write about events and experiences in a detailed and readable way.
- Write essays on topics he/she has clear opinions about, and present his/her argument.
- Read and understand factual texts on topics he/she is not familiar with, if he/she can use a dictionary.
- Make simple notes for study purposes.
