Our three- and four-year-old students alternate attending science class each week. Two certified teachers, Mrs. Renee Amatulli and Ms. Nicole Sobey work opposite sessions to ensure that all of our Nursery and Pre-Kindergarten students have the benefit of science.

Through experimentation and purposeful hands-on experiences, students are fully engaged in their learning. Children are encouraged to observe, investigate, discover, identify, explore and predict. They begin to form logical conclusions as well as develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills. They also learn to appreciate their environment and make meaningful real-world connections.

Mrs. Amatulli and Ms. Sobey spark their curiosity by exploring units and concepts including, but not limited to: germs, magnetism, the five senses, planting, why leaves change color, comparing and contrasting the characteristics of spiders & insects, living vs. non-living, the seasons, day/night, recycling, and the life cycle of lady bugs (three-year-olds) and butterflies (four-year-olds).
