Brothers and sisters in Christ,

Though this may be an exciting time for us as we begin our move into the new fellowship hall this month I want to remind everyone that this past Wednesday February 26th we celebrated Ash Wednesday and officially kicked off Lent. So if there is any joy or happiness of any kind in your heart it is time to dispel it. Lent is a time of preparation and mourning as we join together to focus on our own guilt, misery, and participation in Christ's death. Let the fun begin!

Here at Burke Lutheran as we give up not only the word "ha&%#\$ah" (sorry printing of this word in it's fullness is not allowed until Easter morning) there will also be absolutely no smiling or any other expressions of joy. ## BUILDING UPDATE

If things go as planned we take possession of the new building on Friday, February 28. There are lots of little things to get finished in the new building but the end is in sight!

We will be having another moving day on Saturday, February 29, beginning at 9am for all who are able to help. March 1st will be the last service held in the sanctuary before it is prepped for moving. Following that service we will need some help moving last minute items from the sanctuary to the new building.

Lots of things have already been moved and we will now be starting the process of getting things put away and organized. The picture shows the new Fellowship Hall where everything is currently being stored. Everything will be moved in order for us to hold Lenten service on Wednesday, March 4th.



The next phase of the building project will be the demolition of the old education/office portion of the building, followed by the moving of the sanctuary.

The move of the sanctuary is dependent on the weather. With our warmer winter, the ground might not be frozen enough to move the church. Which means we might have to wait until the ground dries up enough in the spring for the move.

It will be some months before we'll be able to hold services in the sanctuary as work is completed on it.

Our annual Palm Sunday Pancake Breakfast fundraiser may be postponed due to our move into the new building. Watch our bulletins for further updates.


