LAST WEEK GRANT MINNICH SPENT TWO DAYS BERMING SEVERAL TOWNSHIP ROADS.



MOWER TRACTOR HAS BEEN SERVICE D BY KELLER FARM SERVICES AND IS READY FOR THE MOWING SEASON.


