Application Form Food Booth

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Eligibility

Food vendors may not sell arts & crafts or non-food items purchased for resale. Raffles must be preapproved by the festival, are limited to non-profits only, and must comply with Georgia law.

The number of vendors offering the same product will be limited as will the total number of food vendors. The festival does not guarantee that any booth will have sole rights to sell a product, but both vendors and festival goers appreciate a range of food choices. Food vendors are expected to follow cleanliness and food safety practices.

Set-up/Breakdown

Exhibitors must provide their own displays, tables, chairs, extension cords, tents, etc. Be prepared for wind and rain. Electricity will be provided only to vendors specifying on their application. No part of the vendor's display, including tent, may extend past the 12x12 space provided. A dining tent is provided in the festival area. Vendors may set up their own dining areas within their booth spaces. No part of dining areas may extend past the booth space.

Vendors may set up on Friday evening after 5:00 p.m. The festival is not responsible for security overnight; however, the festival area is in front of the Police Station.

Saturday set-up is between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Vendors must be unloaded and vehicles moved by 9:00 a.m. Vendor parking is provided nearby. Breakdown is after 5:00 p.m. No set-up or breakdown will be allowed during show hours.

Clean-up

All trash, garbage and cooking oil must be removed from the booth space at the end of the day. A dumpster will be provided nearby for deposit of trash and garbage.

Deadline and Early Discount

Applications must be received by April 1st to take advantage of the early deadline discount. All fees are due with application. Cancellations will be refunded until April 1st. For the best possible accommodations, applications should be received no later than April 15th. The festival will take place rain or shine. Approximately one week before the festival, vendors will receive site confirmation and detailed information via mail.
