Come, Holy Spirit, Come! Pentecost Sunday May 19 10 AM Worship

Wear RED to celebrate the ongoing work of the Holy Spirit

Thirty-five years ago this month I first set foot in Washington state as I disembarked from an airplane at Seatac. My initial experience of May here, during the week I was househunting, was this: my surroundings were green and lush beyond belief, it was HOT (over 90 for most of the week), and SUNNY and there was this gi-normous mountain which appeared around the corner everywhere I went.

In subsequent years, of course, I came to know that May is manifested and experienced in a variety of ways and it cannot be defined quite so exactly as I perceived it in 1989.

So it is with the Holy Spirit. It is wind. It is breath. It is fire. It is silent. It is the fluttering gliding motion of a dove. It is loud like thunder. It brings comfort. It brings turbulence. It is peace. It is affliction. It prays within us when we cannot find the words to pray. It is whatever God knows we need in order to be raised up into real and abundant life.

The witness of millennia ago is that in the beginning the winds blew over the chaos bringing the voice of God which called the world into being. This rushing of the wind continued to represent God's ever present, ever active, intention in the creation to give and sustain life. I am thankful, in May and in every month, for the work of the Holy Spirit: for stirrings that can nudge us forward and for gale force winds which can lift us up and even turn us around. I can speak only for myself, but I know that sometimes I need to be nudged and other times it takes a bit more force to detach me from my seat.

I hope that you will join us on the Day of Pentecost, May 19, for worship, as we hear witness from scripture (with some dramatic help from adults and children) about this Holy Spirit. If you'd like to read ahead, we will be hearing from Ezekiel 37:1-14 (the breath of life into dry bones), selections from Psalm 104 (Spirit of renewal), Acts 2:1-21(sent to do work of Spirit), and John 15:26-27; 16:4b-15 (Jesus Christ sending the Spirit of Truth).

Crew Stations

*Imagination Station teaches kids in a fun, engaging, experimental way about the daily Bible Point. Instead of making a craft, this is like science experiments that will involve and relate to the Bible verse.

***Bible Adventures** engages the kids physically and emotionally. Crew Leaders guide small-group discussions where kids connect their unforgettable Bible experiences to real life.

*Sticky Scriptures the kids dive in and explore each day's Bible verse through an interactive video. Kids are submerged into the undersea world on a submarine. They'll connect to each Bible verse with their bodies, their heads, and their hearts, led by a Bible Memory Buddy friend.

***Reef Rec** is where kids play games that connect to the daily Bible Point. The games are safe and suitable for ages 5-11.

**Tidal Treats* connects to the Bible Point of the day. As they eat, Crews can get to know each other a little better and have time to make new friends.

*Sing and Play Splash is where kids meet for the opening and closing of each day. Here, the Leader introduces the Bible Point, Bible verse, and Bible Memory Buddy for the day. Kids will sing the theme song, as a celebration of gratitude to God.
