REGISTER TO VOTE

To participate in Ohio state elections or federal elections, you must register to vote ahead of time with the Ohio Secretary of State (SOS). You can do this online or at your local Board of Elections.

**You can also register to vote through the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) while completing driver's license or ID card transactions. You cannot register over the phone.

Voter Registration Deadlines- 2018

You must be registered to vote by OCT 9th, 2018, to vote in the NOV 6th, 2018, General Election.

ABSENTEE VOTING BY MAIL: You may request an application to vote Absentee by mail for any reason beginning JAN 1, 2018 for both the Primary and General Elections. The Application is sent to your requested address. Mail the application back to the Board of Elections for voter information and identity verification. The Ballot is mailed to you the day after Voter Registration is closed. For the 2018 General Election, we begin mailing Absentee Vote by Mail ballots on OCT 10, 2018. Ballots must be returned postmarked no later than NOV 5, 2018 to be counted.
