The Last Bus to Camden is the culmination of over two years of editing and compiling many of Rocky's best poems together into his debut book. This poet has been on the scene for decades, but it wasn't until 2013 that Lamont Steptoe suggested Rocky put together a book of poetry, and tasked Sean Lynch with editing the collection. After hundreds of hours spent in the Paul Robeson library, and a successful Kickstarter campaign, The Last Bus to Camden will be released by Moonstone Arts Center at Fergies pub on Wednesday, March 2nd, at 7pm.

The Last Bus to Camden has gained praise from the likes of poet Jim Cory, who says that, "Rocky Wilson's the real thing: not another rubber stamped MFA poet but a writer whose work begins from feeling & builds its case for what is felt in sure, solid lines..."
