

NO LIMIT VOLLEYBALL PLAYER/PARENT CONTRACT



Accepting a position on a No Limit Volleyball regional or national team is a commitment by the player and player's parents. Acceptance of the position is a dedicated time commitment regardless of other activities, as a national team athlete, that are occurring during the club volleyball season. Regional level athletes are expected to communicate with coaches when other commitments occur during the season that prevent them from attending practices or tournaments. Players and parents are aware and agree to the following:

- No Limit Volleyball players, parents, and fans all represent No Limit Volleyball. It is expected that players, parents, and fans treat fellow teammates, parents, coaches, officials, each other's schools, and communities with respect.
- Bullying in any degree or any form (physical, verbal, written or electronic means) is not tolerated.
- We will submit all required forms and paperwork to the head coach by the first practice in January. All forms can be found on the website
 - Birth Certificate – 2 COPIES (National Athletes)
 - AAU Membership Card (National Athletes)– 2 COPIES
 - USAV Membership Card – 2 COPIES
 - Player Parent Contract
 - USAV Medical Release Form
- We understand that all teams have one mandatory practice per week. National teams have an additional practice. If team is not competing that weekend they will have an additional practice
- We understand that timely attendance at both practices and tournaments is expected. Habitual tardiness or absence, without discussing the situation with the head coach, is unacceptable.
- All vacations/family events/conflicts scheduled during the season will be given in writing to the head coach by the first practice in January.
- In the event of an illness or emergency, we will contact the coach immediately at the phone number provided.
- We understand that if a practice must be missed, we are able to make up the practice with another team on another day.
- For tournaments, players will arrive 1 hour prior to the start time of the tournament for a proper warm up.
- As a parent, participation is limited to that of a spectator. Therefore, parents are not aloud on the floor, bench, or scores table during tournaments, or games. Violation of this is subject to dismissal from tournaments and/or practices.
- We understand and will adhere to the 24/48-hour rule. Any player or parent concern about coaching decisions must wait until 24 hours after the tournament or practice to be communicated and will be considered a closed issue after 48 hours.

o It is not acceptable for a player or parent to communicate with a coach about playtime during the event.

o All issues must be addressed in the following order:

o Players will be included in every discussion a coach has with a parent. Empowering your daughter to advocate for themselves will help them to become strong young ladies!

We agree to the policies as outlined above. We understand that violations of this policy it may result in reduced playing time, suspension from practices or tournaments, or dismissal from the club.
