On August 21st, 2008, Reece Kelley passed away in a tragic accident while playing with his friends. Reece had a big heart and sense of integrity. Reece would be best described by many as a boy who “loved his school, his family, his friends, and his community.” The Reece Kelley Foundation was founded to provide a lasting legacy for an amazing boy and to perpetuate the values that Reece held dear. Reece always attempted to make a difference in the lives of others.

This scholarship is being provided to both a male and a female student who graduates from the Lower Dauphin High School and continues his/her education. It can be awarded for up to four (4) consecutive years at \$1,000 each year provided the following provisions are met:

Initially:

- A written essay on what “making a difference in the lives of others” means to you. And how have/are you making a difference in the lives of others?*
- Written recommendation of a teacher, coach, advisor, or administrator (attached to this application);*
- Applicant must have a High School GPA of 3.0*
- High school enrollment in a school-sponsored extra-curricular activity (drama, band, sports, etc.);*
- Acceptance at an accredited college or university or institution of higher education; and*
- Documented evidence from the community service advisor of the minimum of 20 hours of community service. (attach: written recommendation(s) from the service advisor).*

Subsequent years (data is due no later than July 31st of each year):

- Documented evidence of 20 hours of community service each year;*
- Initially, the applicant must have a 3.0 high school GPA to be eligible for consideration; thereafter, a 2.5 GPA must be maintained.*
- Continued eligibility is based upon four consecutive years with no break in schooling (other than summers)*
