PROJECT GRADUATION 2023 RULES OF THE NIGHT

Please read these rules carefully. They will be enforced so that this will be a safe and enjoyable evening for all participants.

 All students must arrive at the Del Val cafeteria by 8 p.m.
<u>NO senior will be allowed to leave their car parked at the high school overnight.</u> Once you check in at the cafeteria, you will not be permitted to leave. Upon entering the cafeteria, you will also need to initial the registration list. If you do not initial, you will not be admitted.

- There will be <u>NO SMOKING</u> by any student. No chewing tobacco allowed, no vapes.
- No alcohol or controlled substances of any kind will be permitted. Any student arriving at Del Val under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted to participate in the evening's events. Students may be randomly selected for breathalyzer testing. A canine may be on the premise.
- NO backpacks or bags will be permitted. Purses and cargo pants' pockets will need to be searched at check-in.
 Please dispose of drinks or drink containers. They will not be allowed past the check-in point. There are drinks and food provided all evening!
- You will need to make arrangements to have a "non sleep-deprived" driver pick you up around 5:30 / 6:00 am on Saturday. This is for everyone's safety. You will check into the cafeteria once getting off of the buses to receive your door prizes from the night before, and the gifts that each participant receives. (Your ride can come in and get these gifts before your arrival if they want to. This process goes fast; we know everyone is tired and just wants to go home to bed!)
- Any violation of these rules will require that you leave the event immediately. Your parent or guardian will be called to pick you up. Proper authorities will be notified in the case of any illegal violation.
