Alta Mesa Gun Club Range and Safety Rules

(Read, Sign and Date)

Range and Safety Rules

1. Range officers have final say in any or all decision making.
2. No outdoor trap shooting allowed without two (2) Range officers present.
3. Shoot card/ticket must be punched by a Range officer prior to going to the firing line.
4. Do not place shell or shells in gun unless you are on firing line.
5. Load one shell at a time for single and two for doubles.
6. When changing stations your gun must be unloaded and action open.
7. Always keep your gun pointed downrange.
8. Never point your gun at any person, clubhouse or buildings.
9. Always carry and rack your gun with action open.
10. In the event of delay on firing line, always unload your gun and leave action open.
11. Make certain your shells are same gauge as your gun.
12. No shooting except on firing line.
13. Never put a loaded gun in your car.
14. AMGC does not permit the consumption of alcoholic beverages on the shooting line.
15. Anyone intoxicated will not be allowed to handle a firearm.
16. Ear and eye protection is strongly recommended for all adults.
17. Ear and eye protection is required for those less than 18 years old.
18. No high base shells allowed on the grounds – low base shells only.
19. Maximum load: Not to exceed #7 ½ shot or 1 1/8 oz. load.
20. No hunting on grounds.
21. No hand throwers allowed.
22. All shooters (members and non-members) must sign the daily range roster.
23. All members must sign in and out when using the club.
24. Shooting days as allowed per County of Sacramento's Certificate of Nonconforming Use Permit.

RANGE OFFICERS HAVE FINAL SAY IN ANY AND ALL DECISION MAKING, INCLUDING CLOSING THE RANGE DOWN.
