MEMBER NEWS

At the January Membership Meeting the Board recommended and had discussion about replacing the dilapidated side door with a new door and adding ADA-accessibility. There was a motion made and passed by the membership to bring this to a vote with the amount not to exceed \$9,000. This will be voted on at the February 6 th Membership Meeting.

Gift Cards: We now have a new plastic refillable gift card for MLBC. These cards can be purchased and loaded with a customized amount. There is a onetime \$2 processing fee for the purchase of a gift card. We are also utilizing these cards as our new Volunteer Appreciation credits. Store credit will be issued on the card and reloaded with credits each time you volunteer. You keep the same card, and we refill as needed. If lost there will be a \$2 charge for a new one. This process eliminates the volunteer tickets and voucher system. These can be used for food, beverage, and merchandise. If you are a volunteer with tickets or vouchers to use up, please do so as quickly as possible. We would like to have a solitary system in place as quickly as possible to keep our record keeping clean. Special Events: During special events like Cheap Date Night, we would ask that you not redeem your volunteer appreciation card/tickets/vouchers during special events. We would love you to enjoy that value during regular Club hours as well as regular dinner and lunch services.

Beginning Wednesday, February 1, 2023, the lunch menu will be revised to include Member and Non-Member pricing. The pricing for lunch menu items will not increase for Members that show their current 2023 Membership Card. There will however be an increase of Wednesday and Friday lunch items of \$2.00 for meals. For Tacos, the same will go into effect with a \$1.00 upcharge for Non-Members. The Board decision was based on Membership input at several membership meetings and creates a better value for those that pay membership dues. Please have your cards available to receive your membership perks when you cash out just like you do for Variety Dinners.
