### Kindergarten

- 1 – 3 pack of large glue sticks
- 1 box of markers (10 in box)
- 1 art smock (over-sized t-shirt, labeled in a zip-lock bag to be left in school)
- Note: Please do not have your child bring a rolling backpack with wheels and handles. They do not fit in our cubbies. The backpack should be large enough to fit a folder and some library books.

### First Grade

- 1 plastic 2 pocket folder for home/school communication
- 1 box of crayons 24 count size only please
- 1 art smock (old t-shirt or button down shirt, labeled in a zip-lock bag to be left in school)
- A selection of JUST RIGHT favorite books for the first few days of school including one book they read over the summer that they really, really loved.
- Note: Please do not have your child bring a rolling backpack with wheels and handles. They do not fit in our cubbies. The backpack should be large enough to fit a folder and some library books.

### Second Grade

- 12 sharpened pencils
- 3 glue sticks

- 1 box of crayons (24 size)
- Small pencil pouch (zippered vinyl or small plastic pencil box)
- A 1" three ring binder for reading workshop
- 1 art smock (old t-shirt or button down shirt, labeled in a zip-lock bag to be left in school)
- A selection of JUST RIGHT favorite books for the first few days of school including one book they read over the summer that they really, really loved.

### Third Grade

- Sharpened pencils and erasers (with a pencil pouch)
- 1 pocket folder for homework and notes
- 1 pocket folder for unfinished work
- One spiral notebook and folder for music
- 1 art smock (labeled in a zip lock bag)
- 1 old sock for wiping whiteboards
- A selection of JUST RIGHT favorite books for the first few days of school including one book they read over the summer that they really, really loved.

### Fourth Grade

- 2 dozen sharpened pencils
- 1 dozen post-it notes (any color)
- Small pencil pouch (small, please)
- 2 Sturdy plastic 2-pocket folders
- 1 art smock (over-sized t-shirt, labeled in a zip-lock bag to be left in school)
- Headphones or earbuds (locked in a labeled ziplock bag) for use with Chromebooks
- A selection of JUST RIGHT favorite books for the first few days of school including one book they read over the summer that they really, really loved.

### Fifth Grade

- One 2-inch binder (can be a zipper "Case it" binder)
- Six 1-subject notebooks (not one large 6-subject notebook)
- 2-3 boxes of sharpened pencils
- 3 folders
- Red and blue pens
- Small pencil pouch
- 1 Pair of headphones (used for Chromebooks)
- 1 art smock or earbuds (locked in a labeled ziplock bag) for use with Chromebooks
- A selection of JUST RIGHT favorite books for the first few days of school including one book they read over the summer that they really, really loved.
