2014 TAX ANTICIPATION LINE OF CREDIT

Mr. Apfelbaum explained that each year the city borrows \$250,000 in anticipation of receiving taxes later in the year. The note must be paid off by December 31st of the same year. Swineford National Bank was the low bidder for 2014. Councilman Eister moved to pass the Resolution for the tax anticipation line of credit for 201q4 and authorize the mayor to sign all documents. Second – Reichner. Unanimous vote. A closing will be scheduled for January 13th.
