Harvey B. Bowen, 79, of Green Valley, Arizona and former resident of Harbor Beach, went to his heavenly home on March 10, 2005. Harvey was born on July 30, 1925 in Charlevoix County, son of the late Irvie and Gertrude Bowen. Harvey is survived by his wife of 56 years, Beth, of Green Valley, Arizona; sons, David, of Lakeville, Minnesota, and Phil and his wife, Cathy, of Harbor Beach; a sister, Katherine Cina, of Tacoma, Washington; brother, Fred and his wife, Sandy, of Clinton Township; a brother-in-law, John Clifford and his wife, Martha, of St. Louis, Missouri; two grandsons, Patrick Bowen and his wife, Aleaha, of Lansing, and Drew Bowen, of Harbor Beach; nieces and nephews as well as grand nieces and nephews.
