**CAT:** The Coursing Ability Test (CAT) is an introductory event fashioned after the sport of lure coursing. It will provide a fun and healthy activity attractive to many dog owners.

CAT Test: running order will be posted after roll call

CAT is open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program.
