HOW TO SAVE ON ELECTRIC BILLS?

<u>Seal it up!</u> Check for leaks around windows, doors and other openings to to outside. Seal these leaks with caulk to keep the warmth in.

<u>Furnance Checkup!</u> Have your furnace and heating system inspected annually to check for leaks or other problems.

<u>Insulate!</u> Wrap old water heaters with proper insulating jackets and set the temperature to 120F (or lower). Insulate your plumbing.

<u>Use mother nature!</u> When it's cold outside but also sunny, open the blinds during the day to let the sun help heat your home.

<u>Wash cold!</u> Whenever possible, use the cold water setting on your washing machine.

<u>Check and replace HVAC filters!</u> New filters usually only cost a few dollars. Dirty filters cost more to use, overwork the equipment and result in lower indoor air quality. The filters should be replaced regularly.

<u>Control the temperature!</u> Set the temperature to 68F or lower in the winter. A programmable thermostat can make it easy to set back your temperature.
