Starting 1st with SALVATION ... Salvation means the act of being saved from danger or destruction

The Church the Body of Christ’s Salvation is in three major parts:

- 1. Saved from the Penalty of Sin (Justification): the act of God declaring sinners righteous by the blood of Christ, I Cor 15:22**
- 2. Saved from the Power of Sin (Sanctification): Believers set apart to live holy unto God. Rom 6:11-18**
- 3. Saved from the Presence of Sin (Glorification): Believers with new bodies at the Rapture! Phil 3:30-21**

There are 9 types of SALVATION in Paul’s writings to the Church the Body of Christ, in the Dispensation of Grace”:

<p>Saved from the Penalty of Sin: (Justification) Unconditional 1.
