Clemson QB Trevor Lawrence and the No. 3 Tigers ran away from No. 2 Notre Dame last Saturday 34-10 to win the ACC Championship game. Clemson easily covered as 11-point favorites and will face No. 3 Ohio State in the CFB Playoff semi-final. Notre Dame dropped to No. 4 and will play No. 1 Alabama in the other semi-final.

Misleading Finals

Nebraska (-6.5) beat Rutgers 28-21. However, Nebraska dominated much more than the final as the Huskers had 27-9 first down and 620-252 yard edges including 365-130 on the ground. Nebraska had 4 TO's and Rutgers got a 98-yard kickoff return TD to make the final more respectable.

Oregon (+3) upset USC 31-24 to win the Pac-12 Championship. However, USC had 25-16 first down and 358-243 yard edges but also had 3 TO's. Oregon had TD drives of 9 yards, 32 yards and 41 yards in the first half.

Bad Beats

Washington (+11.5) backers were covering most of the game vs Utah. The Cougars led 28-7 at halftime and were covering by 32.5 points at that time. However, Utah outscored them 38-0 in the second half! Washington St looked like they were going to get the back-door cover but fumbled at the Utah 9-yard line in the final seconds.

Injuries/COVID Cases

We had 9 games postponed or cancelled last week including UL-Monroe at Troy, Purdue at Indiana, Georgia Tech at Miami, Florida State at Wake Forest, Michigan at Iowa, Michigan State at Maryland, Arizona at California, UL-Lafayette at Coastal Carolina and Vanderbilt at Georgia.

This week's Gasparilla Bowl between South Carolina/UAB was cancelled due to positive cases at South Carolina. Army has replaced Tennessee in next week's Liberty Bowl game vs West Virginia.

Alabama starting center Landon Dickerson is out for the season with a knee injury. Buffalo RB Jaret Patterson has been upgraded to probable vs Marshall. Florida TE Kyle Pitts opted out of the bowl game and will prep for the NFL Draft. Marshall RB Brenden Knox opted out of the bowl game. Marshall's leading tackler Tavante Beckett also opted out of the game as did offensive tackle Josh Bell. Three of North Carolina's top players including LB Chazz Surratt, WR Dyami Brown and RB Michael Carter opted out of the bowl game. Wisconsin QB Graham Mertz (upper body) is questionable vs Wake Forest.

Recapping Week 16 Best Bets

Our college best bets went 2-0 on these pages last week. Our top play UL-Lafayette was cancelled due to COVID issues at Coastal Carolina. We won outright with Stanford in what was a very frustrating game. The Cardinal led 20-3 at halftime but then allowed 31 unanswered points and weren't covering again until a last second TD forced OT. Tulsa was a nice winner for us. The NFL continues to be a shit show. We went 0-3. Denver had no chance on Saturday night. Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past four seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game. Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 302-252-12 (55%) clip the last three years. That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Last week's plays went 4-1 and now the record for this year is 68-47 (59%). Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

Houston comes in at 3-4 on the season (-1 ppg and +6 ypg) and breaking down their season is quite simple: The Cougars won and covered vs the three weakest teams they faced (all outside our Top 60 of our power ratings) and UH lost and failed to cover vs the four strongest teams they faced. Hawaii would fall into that weaker category. Speaking of the Rainbow Warriors, they enter at 4-4 on the season (-3 ppg and -23 ypg) but played a much weaker schedule than Houston. Their offense is basically QB Chevan Cordeiro who has a 11-6 ratio and also leads the team in rushing with 452 and 7 TD's. We were all set in backing Houston here but head coach Dana Holgorsen yesterday said the Cougars would be missing 15-20 players due to Covid protocols, injury and players who are academically ineligible (line dropped a couple of points). We'll lean with the **OVER** instead as the specifics about which players weren't released (our power ratings say Houston by 12.2).

Friday, December 25th

Camellia Bowl in Montgomery, AL

Lean **UNDER**. † Buffalo 28 Marshall 23. One month ago Marshall was in the AP Top 15 and there was talk of a major bowl game. Then the Thundering Herd were upset as 24-point favorites to Rice (lost 20-0) and those hopes and dreams were squashed. Marshall followed up that poor performance and were dominated much more than the final vs UAB in the CUSA Championship (outgained by 200 yards). This team is now a shell of their former selves as leading rusher Brenden Knox (887 yards), OT Josh Ball and LB Tavante Beckett (90 tackles) all opted out this week. All were 1st-team All-CUSA selections. On the other side, Buffalo's unbeaten season came to an end last week when they were upset by Ball St in the MAC Championship. Still, the Bulls are outscoring their foes by 24 ppg and are +130 ypg and RB Jaret Patterson (1,072 yards and 19 TD's) will play here. Marshall is 6-1 SU/ATS in bowls under Doc Holliday but with three major opt outs, we can't back them. We lean **UNDER** as this is the best D Buffalo has faced and we don't think Marshall will be successful on offense without RB Knox.

Saturday, December 26th

Gasparilla Bowl in Tampa, FL

South Carolina vs UAB is cancelled due to COVID issues at South Carolina.

Cure Bowl in Orlando, FL

1★ Liberty (+7.5). Coastal Carolina 31 Liberty 27. Two of the best Group of 5 teams in the country meet here. These two teams were supposed to meet a few weeks ago but Liberty had to cancel due to COVID issues and Coastal re-scheduled them with BYU and pulled off the big upset in front of ESPN College GameDay. Liberty enters with 7 straight covers by an average of 11 ppg. The Flames were +19 ppg and +182 ypg on the season despite playing 3 ACC teams (3-0 ATS vs them). They are led by an outstanding QB in Malik Willis who threw for 2,040 yards (20-4 ratio) and also led the team with 807 rush yards (10 TD's). Meanwhile, Coastal enters a perfect 11-0 on the season and were +18 ppg and +106 ypg. They also have a dynamic QB in Grayson McCall who has 23-2 ratio and has run for 473 yards and 6 TD's. Liberty played here in last year's Cure Bowl and head coach Hugh Freeze is 4-1 SU/ATS in bowls. Meanwhile, Coastal is making their first ever bowl appearance. We think that experience edge is the difference here (our power ratings have Coastal by 5.2).

First Responder Bowl in Dallas, TX

1★ UNDER 57. † UL-Lafayette 33 Utsa 20. Louisiana comes in at 9-1 on the season with their only loss vs unbeaten Coastal Carolina and their win over Iowa St in the opener looks better by the week. The Ragin' Cajuns are led by a powerful run game with 3 capable backs in Elijah Mitchell, Trey Ragas and Chris Smith combining for 1,745 yards. QB Levi Lewis has a 17-7 ratio while also adding 5 rushing TD's. Meanwhile, UTSA had a very successful first season under first-year head coach Jeff Traylor. They improved from 4-8 last year to 7-4 this year. The Roadrunners are led by RB Sincere McCormick who had 1,345 rush yards and 11 TD's. Four different QB's took significant snaps (due to injury) but Frank Harris should be good to go here. BYU, UAB and Army all had difficulties getting margin on UTSA (all 3 losses by 12 points or less) and all 3 of those games went **UNDER**. ULL games are averaging just 56 total ppg and UTSA games only 54 total ppg. The two teams are a combined 15-6 to the **UNDER** this year. That's where our money is.

Lending Tree Bowl in Mobile, AL

Passing. † Georgia St 27 Western Kentucky 24. Georgia St had a solid season at 5-4 and were playing some of their best ball down the stretch with 3 straight covers but they've been off a month now. Their offense averages 33 ppg and 418 ypg and is led by QB Cornelius Brown who also ran for 7 TD's. Meanwhile, WKU had a very disappointing start to the season as the Hilltoppers were 0-6-1 ATS. They started to play better down the stretch as they enter this one with 3 straight wins but still have a 5-6 record as they have been outgained by 45 ypg and outscored by 5 ppg on the season. QB Tyrrell Pigrome remarkably has not thrown an interception all year (9-0 ratio) despite only a 58% completion rate. We question the offensive philosophy in not using RB Gaej Walker more but he did have his two best rushing outputs in the last two games and WKU in return had their two best performances. We don't have a strong take here. If you can find a +4, we would lean with WKU as our power ratings have them losing by 3.

Friday, December 25th (Merry Christmas!!!)

NEW ORLEANS 30 Minnesota 21. That's now 5 straight non-covers for Minnesota who basically saw their season come to an end with a loss to Chicago last week (much to our dismay on these pages). They're taking on a New Orleans team that needs a feel good win after a pair of losses will most likely prevent them from getting the No. 1 seed in the NFC. QB Brees was rusty (only completed 15 of 34 passes) but the offense started to pick it up in the second half vs the Chiefs. The Saints have lost to the Vikings in heart-breaking fashion twice in the playoffs the last 3 years. They get some revenge here.

Saturday, December 26th

1★ OVER 54 Tampa Bay 34 DETROIT 24. Kudos to the Bucs who pulled the big come-from-behind win to beat the Falcons last week (trailed 17-0). That kept them in the hunt for the NFC South title along with the Saints losing the last two weeks. With that said, we haven't been overly impressed with Tampa. They are taking on a Detroit team that has an interim coach and could be just playing out the season at this point. While the Lions offense has averaged 27 ppg the last 4 weeks, their defense is allowing 37 ppg and is banded up in the secondary. We like the OVER which is on a 11-2 run in Detroit's last 13 home games.

ARIZONA 27 San Francisco 21. The Cardinals have righted their ship as they've won and covered two straight (were on a 0-5 ATS run) to remain in the playoff hunt. Meanwhile, the same can't be said for the 49ers who have dropped 3 straight games all as a favorite. Turnovers are the main culprit (-4 last week) as they've had 8 straight games with 2 or more (longest streak since 2008). We cashed on these pages on Arizona in the season opener as they upset the 49ers as TD underdogs (feels like a lifetime ago). Now they're laying 5 at home, which is also the place the 49ers have called home in recent weeks. Still, Arizona has had San Francisco's number as of late (5-0 ATS)..

Miami 27 LAS VEGAS 24. After showing some promise this season, the Raiders are starting to crumble. They have failed to cover the spread in 4 straight games and last week lost outright as FG favorites at home to the Chargers in OT. Their playoff hopes are hanging by a thread. Meanwhile, Miami continues to defy expectation as the Dolphins are an NFL-best 11-3 ATS on the season and we lost going up against them last week with New England as they rallied in the second half for the win. As of press time, the Raiders haven't decided who they will start at QB as Mariota did look good after replacing Carr last week. We lean OVER which is 10-3-1 in Raiders games this year.

Sunday, December 27th

L.A. CHARGERS 26 Denver 24. Last week we had an embarrassing loser on these pages with Denver who were crushed at home to Buffalo. Still, the Broncos haven't been that bad this season despite the fact they've been an underdog in every single game. Meanwhile, the Chargers have extra rest after their Thursday Night OT win over the Raiders. That's now two straight wins for them on the final play of the game despite repeated coaching blunders. The Chargers will want revenge for losing on the final play to Denver back in Week 8 as they blew a 24-3 lead. Laying points is not optimal anytime you're looking to back a Anthony Lynn-led team especially at home where they are on a 1-8-1 ATS run as a home favorite. Lean Denver an OVER.

Cleveland 28 N.Y. JETS 18. This is the largest away favorite role for the Browns since at least 1989 (that's as far back as our database goes). Obviously, Cleveland backers are feeling good about themselves after the SNF win over the Giants last week moved them one step closer to a rare playoff berth. They are playing back-to-back games in the same stadium. Meanwhile, the Jets are celebrating their first win of the season as they pulled the shocker of the year beating the Rams as 17-point underdogs. That's the good news. The bad news is they lost their grip on getting the No. 1 pick in the Draft. Also teams coming off an outright upset as a 14-point or more underdog are 0-10 SU (-14 ppg) and 0-9-1 ATS (-9 ppg) the following week since 1995. We're passing.

HOUSTON 27 Cincinnati 17. Cincy is in a bad spot here traveling on a short week (and it's Christmas) after pulling off a huge upset over a division rival on MNF. We already mentioned in the Jets write-up that a week after pulling a 2-TD or more upset, teams are 0-9-1 ATS since 1995. They're taking on a Houston team that suffered another tough loss to the Colts last week. Even though the teams have similar records (Houston 4-10, Cincinnati 3-10-1), they are very disparate in terms of talent at the most important position...QB. We lean with the home team.

PITTSBURGH 23 Indianapolis 22. There is a hang-over for teams that lose as 2-TD or more favorites the previous week. Since 2009, they are 0-5 SU and 0-4-1 ATS off that shocking loss (would also apply to the Rams this week). Obviously, the Steelers are reeling after their 11-0 start as they've lost 3 straight games including that MNF shocker to the Bengals. Meanwhile, the Colts have been favored in every game but one this year (at Cleveland) and are off 3 straight wins. The look-ahead line saw Pittsburgh favored by 3 in this match-up. We think there's been an over-reaction in the market to Pittsburgh's shocking loss to Cincy and lean with the Steelers.

Chicago 28 JACKSONVILLE 20. The Bears remain in the playoff hunt after pulling back-to-back upsets over Houston and Minnesota the last two weeks. They've only been favored in two games this year so they have over-achieved at 7-7 (even though it doesn't feel like it). Despite a blowout loss to the Ravens last week, the Jags organization has to feel like it won with the Jets winning. Jacksonville now has the inside track on the No. 1 pick in the NFL Draft, which is likely to be Trevor Lawrence. Will they give 100% effort here? The defense sure hasn't allowing 24 or more points in 13 straight games (2nd longest streak in NFL history). It's a short sample but Bears QB Trubisky is playing well right now and the Jags are 7-25 ATS vs the NFC since mid-2012.

1★ Carolina 23 WASHINGTON 22. It will be interesting to see what Washington does at QB here with Alex Smith being banged up and Dwayne Haskins probably on his way out the door after yet another questionable decision (was caught mask-less in a strip club after the team's loss to Seattle on Sunday). Meanwhile, Carolina had a solid effort vs the Packers last week in a cover as they had a 364-291 yard edge. This will be an emotional game for Washington head coach Ron Rivera who was fired from Carolina last year after a mostly-successful 9-year run. Still, the Panthers have been incredible as dogs this year with a 8-1 ATS run in that role and we think they win outright especially if Haskins has to play again.

BALTIMORE 27 N.Y. Giants 16. Baltimore is now playing their best ball of the season. They've covered 4 straight games and despite being in a tough spot last week (short week of Game of Year vs Cleveland), they crushed the Jags. Meanwhile, the Giants have lost two straight and now need some help from Washington to get back in the NFC East race. Their offense has put up a total of 13 points the last two games which won't cut it vs the powerful Baltimore offense. The UNDER has cashed in 5 straight NYG games. Make it 6. Do note the Giants have covered all 6 times as a road dog this year.

KANSAS CITY 31 Atlanta 22. Give credit to the Chiefs for sitting a top the NFL with a 13-1 record. Still, this teams looks bored at times and they rarely play a complete 60 minutes. They've won 9 straight games but look at their scoring margins as of late. They beat Carolina by only 2, Las Vegas by 4, Tampa by 3, Denver by 6, Miami by 6 and last week at the Saints by 3. Do you really want to lay more than 10 here? The only hang-up is how does Atlanta respond after blowing yet another huge lead last week. With an interim coach, they could wave the white flag on the season.

2★ L.A. Rams 24 SEATTLE 22. We'll keep it simple...we like the Rams here. They're the better team and you don't have to worry about the 12th man. Yes, they were stunted last week in the loss to the Jets as 17-point favorites but it's obvious they were looking ahead to this all-important game in the AFC West. The Rams won the earlier meeting 23-16 and have had the Seahawks number as of late winning 5 of the last 6 meetings. Their outstanding defensive line gets pressure up the middle which is a key in defending QB Wilson. Totals' players note Rams games are 10-4 to the UNDER this year and each of the last 6 Seattle games have gone UNDER as their defense has allowed just 16 ppg in that stretch.

Philadelphia 25 DALLAS 24. Both teams have faint division title hopes but both have played better as of late. The winner stays in the mix while the loser is out of it. The Eagles offense has been given new life with Jalen Hurts under center. Last week he had 401 total yards and 4 total TD's in the loss at Arizona. The Cowboys have scored 30 and 41 points the last two weeks in a pair of wins but note they benefitted from +4 TO's last week in the upset of San Francisco. We'd only be interested in taking Dallas if the line goes to +3.

GREEN BAY 30 Tennessee 27. Really good SNF match-up here. The Packers can clinch the No. 1 seed in the NFC with a win here. They come in off 4 straight wins but have failed to cover the last two games as TD-plus favorites. Meanwhile, Tennessee comes in off back-to-back blowout wins and should be rested here. Tennessee might be a bad match-up here for Green Bay if you remember San Francisco's powerful run game having success vs the Packers last season and Tennessee RB Henry is well on his way to leading the league again in rushing. For those wanting to bet the OVER, there is some snow in the forecast. Tennessee games are 10-3-1 to the OVER this year but Green Bay games are on a 7-4 run to the UNDER. Too close to call right now.

Monday, December 28th

Buffalo 25 NEW ENGLAND 19. We did not have a good feel for either of these teams' last week as we lost fading the Bills in their blowout win over Denver. And we lost backing the Pats as they blew a halftime lead vs the Dolphins (we took them +2.5 and they closed -1, so much for closing line value). This is the first time the Pats have been a home underdog to the Bills since 1999 and the largest underdog role for them in the series since 1993. It is deserved. The Bills wrapped up their first division since 1995 last week and the Patriots have been officially eliminated from the playoffs for the first time since 2008. That's 2020 for you. Tough fading the Bills who have covered 6 straight now but we're not fading Belichick as a 7-point home dog. Lean UNDER which has cashed in 6 straight New England games.
