
OCTOBER 20 - WORLD MISSION SUNDAY: At the initiative of Pope Pius XI in 1926, the second last Sunday

October 22 - Memorial of Saint John Paul II, Pope: Born in 1920. Karol Józef Wojtyla was ordained a Priest in 1946, appointed Auxiliary Bishop of Krakow 1958. appointed in Archbishop of Krakow in 1964, created a Cardinal in 1967, and elected Pope in 1978, taking the name of John Paul II. His love for young people led him to establish the World Youth Days, bringing together millions of young people. In 1984, John Paul II was

the first Pope to step foot on Canadian soil, visiting numerous cities from the Atlantic to the Pacific. In 1987 he returned to meet with the Aboriginal Peoples of the Northwest Territories, and again in 2002 for World Youth Day in Toronto. His pontificate lasted nearly 27 years. He died on April 2, 2005, and was canonized on April 27, 2014. Saint John Paul II is the patron saint of World Youth Day, and in Canada, April 2 is known nationally as John Paul II Day.
