When: February 20, 2015

Cost: \$2 per girl, includes passport and patch.

Each year around February 22, girls participate in activities and projects with global themes to honor their sister Girl Guides and Girl Scouts in other countries. This special day is called, World Thinking Day.

How to participate:

- Reserve a table for FREE and choose a country as a troop.
 - Research your selected country to provide facts to teach other Girl Scouts about that country.
 - Give a 2-3 minute presentation, such as sing a song from the country or tell a story about the Girl Guides in that Country.
 - Create a trifold display with facts and photos
 - Provide food and dessert samples that are popular in that country.
 - Make little crafts or swaps that will represent your specific country to provide as giveaways.
- **Purchase tickets ahead of time and attend the event**. At the event, girls will collect a passport and World Thinking Day patch. We will gather as a group to watch a presentation from each representing troop, then walk around to each table to get the passport stamped and learn more about that country's culture, sample their food and desserts and get a swap or little craft to take home.
