# Conditions of the Competition – Eastern Amateur First Flight Tournament June 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>, 2016

In 2016, the First Flight of the Eastern Amateur Championship will be held at Elizabeth Manor Golf & Country Club in Portsmouth, Virginia. Application to the Championship is open to male amateur golfers with a current USGA Handicap Index, with at least five scores posted during the current year. It will be 36 holes at Stroke Play with all contestants pre-flighted by handicap Index, with the low gross total determining the flight winners and overall Champion. In the event of a tie for first place, a hole-by-hole playoff will be held. All losers in this playoff will be treated as runners-up and will receive identical prizes. All other ties will be decided matching cards using the method shown on page 161 in the USGA Rules of Golf. The low nine gross scores and the low three gross scores for Elizabeth Manor members will qualify to compete in the Eastern Amateur Championship, subject to paying an additional \$75 entry fee. Ties for those positions will be played off in a hole-by-hole playoff.

The Committee reserves the right to cut the field and/or change the schedule and/or duration of the tournament if weather and/or any other conditions so dictate.

The First Flight will be conducted under USGA Rules and Local Rules. The Tournament Committee reserves to itself full authority to interpret such rules, and its decisions shall be final. Any decisions not covered by the preceding for the Eastern Amateur Championship shall be referred to the Tournament Committee and its decision shall be final.

The Committee shall establish the time of starting for all play. Players are expected to be at their designated tee at the time assigned for their group. Players may use automotive transportation. Fees for carts are NOT included in the entry fee. Only balls on the USGA's list of conforming balls may be used. Breach of this condition will result in disqualification. The One-Ball Rule is NOT in effect for this competition.

Participants in the Eastern Amateur First Flight are expected to behave in a sportsmanlike manner. A player who throws club, uses foul or abusive language, causes property damage or otherwise behaves inappropriately will be directed to leave the golf course.

A Pace-of-Play Policy will be in effect during the competition. A copy of that policy will be provided for each player prior to the start of play. All players shall be attired in normal golf attire (Golf shorts are included) at all times, both on the golf course and at the practice areas.
